<p>Commuter Check Card Prepaid MasterCard (see also step-by-step instructions on iCommute site)</p> <p>Step 1: Select Transit Order Step 2: Select your Greater Metropolitan Area "San Francisco" Step 3: Select your Provider "Commuter Check Card Prepaid MasterCard"</p>	YES	NO	<p>MasterCard is used as a funding source for your Clipper card account. Set up via Autoload for BART high-value discount at Clipper website.</p> <p><u>Pros:</u> maximum saving (BART discount plus pre-tax saving)</p> <p><u>Cons:</u> complicated to set up and maintain, having to keep track of both MasterCard and Clipper account</p> <p>NOTE: Clipper card account is your responsibility; Commuter Check Direct is only responsible for your MasterCard account and the fund amount you order loaded onto the MasterCard.</p>
<p>Clipper - BART \$64 High Value Ticket (only up to 3 tickets)</p> <p>Step 1: Select Transit Order Step 2: Select your Greater Metropolitan Area "San Francisco" Step 3: Select your Provider "Clipper" Step 4: Select "BART High Value Ticket (\$64 value)"</p>	YES	YES	<p>Fund goes directly to your Clipper card account.</p> <p><u>Pros:</u> easy to set up</p> <p><u>Cons:</u> pay additional \$2 transaction fee per successful load</p>
<p>Clipper - E-Cash</p> <p>Step 1: Select Transit Order Step 2: Select your Greater Metropolitan Area "San Francisco" Step 3: Select your Provider "Clipper" Step 4: Select "Clipper E-Cash"</p>	NO	YES	<p>Fund goes directly to your Clipper card account.</p> <p><u>Pros:</u> easy to set up and you can also choose the exact amount you need each month</p> <p><u>Cons:</u> worst saving (no BART discount and pay additional \$2 transaction fee)</p>
<p>Commuter Check Voucher</p> <p>Step 1: Select Transit Order Step 2: Select your Greater Metropolitan Area "San Francisco" Step 3: Select your Provider "Commuter Check Voucher"</p>	NO	NO	<p>You have to redeem the voucher at participating transit agencies or retailers to have the fund loaded onto your Clipper card account.</p> <p><u>Pros:</u> easy to set up</p> <p><u>Cons:</u> inconvenient to have to redeem the voucher each time; no BART discount (just pre-tax saving)</p>
