- Scope of plan includes: renewal or replacement of inadequate mechanical and fire sprinkler systems, adaptive renovation of student spaces including library, classrooms and student commons, and renewal of historic exterior.
- Projects to be phased as fundraising occurs: individual projects anticipated to be within Chancellor authority.
- Budget represents elements of scope not eligible for capital renewal funds.
