## **Project Description**

- Expands the Activities and Recreation Center (ARC), the main student fitness and recreational facility on the campus.
- Enrollment has increased by approximately 6,000 since the ARC opened in 2002. As a result, the ARC's weigt room and cardio equipment are not meeting current student demand.
- Project will construct additional fitness activity space and reconfigure some existing space to optimize utilization of the facility.
- Project expands into the ARC courtyard and captures additional space within the existing ARC to provide approximately 26,000 GSF to alleviates overcrowding issues currently impacting the fitness/cardio center.
