• Provides classrooms and office space for University Extension (UNEX) programs.

• Addresses current unmet demand for classes in UNEX's International Studies program. UNEX is turning away approximately 200 ESL students per term due to lack of classroom space.

• Includes one floor of shell space (11,000 GSF) to make more effective use of the site and to provide future flexibility for UNEX programs, and includes the construction of a pedestrian bridge from the project site over East Peltason Drive to provide safe access for students and residents from the East Campus to the academic core.

• Replaces approximately 13,000 ASF of off-campus leased space currently occupied by UNEX administrative units.

• Will meet LEED<sup>TM</sup> Silver with an alternate for Gold.
