Project Description

- Constructs a 65-meter regulation pool, pool deck, and support facilities (mechanical, electrical, pumps, and filtration equipment), including those required for NCAA Division I swim meets and water polo matches, in order to accommodate men's and women's intercollegiate swimming and water polo, and recreational activities.
- Replaces non-NCAA-compliant campus pool and locker rooms built in 1943, and also provides , concession and ticket-office facilities, bleacher seating, new electronic scoreboards, officials' areas, and space for television and media operations.
- Replaces obsolete facilities that are too small to accommodate competitive swimming and water polo programs and recreational use.
- Project will proceed when sufficient funding is available; partial gift funding is in hand.
