Mr. Kowalski has been the Director of Constituent and Legislative Coordination in Human Resources and Benefits at the Office of the President since April 2002. He is responsible for relationships between HR and Benefits and groups like CUCSA, CUCRA (retirees' association), CUCEA (emeriti association) and the Academic Senate's Faculty Welfare Committee. He is also responsible for HR and Benefits' analysis and implementation of state legislation that may affect UC, and for preparation and submission of HR and Benefits items that come before the Regents.

Before becoming Director of Constituent and Legislative Coordination, Mr. Kowalski served about a year as Director of Analysis and Research in the Policy, Planning and Research Unit and three years as Director of Compensation Planning and Analysis – both in HR and Benefits at the Office of the President.

Capping 26 years of private sector experience, Mr. Kowalski also spent 13 years with Pacific Telesis Group (San Francisco) in Financial Management and Executive Compensation positions. He holds a BS in Management Science and an MBA from the University of Rochester in upstate New York.
