

History of Recycling at UCSF

1997 – 1998

To minimize waste going to landfills, UCSF & Sunset Scavenger Co. initiated the first recycling program.

1998

SVC Steve Barclay initiated and secured funding for professional staff to develop a new Recycling Program

1999

Basic Recycling on campuses included paper, cans, bottles & cardboard.

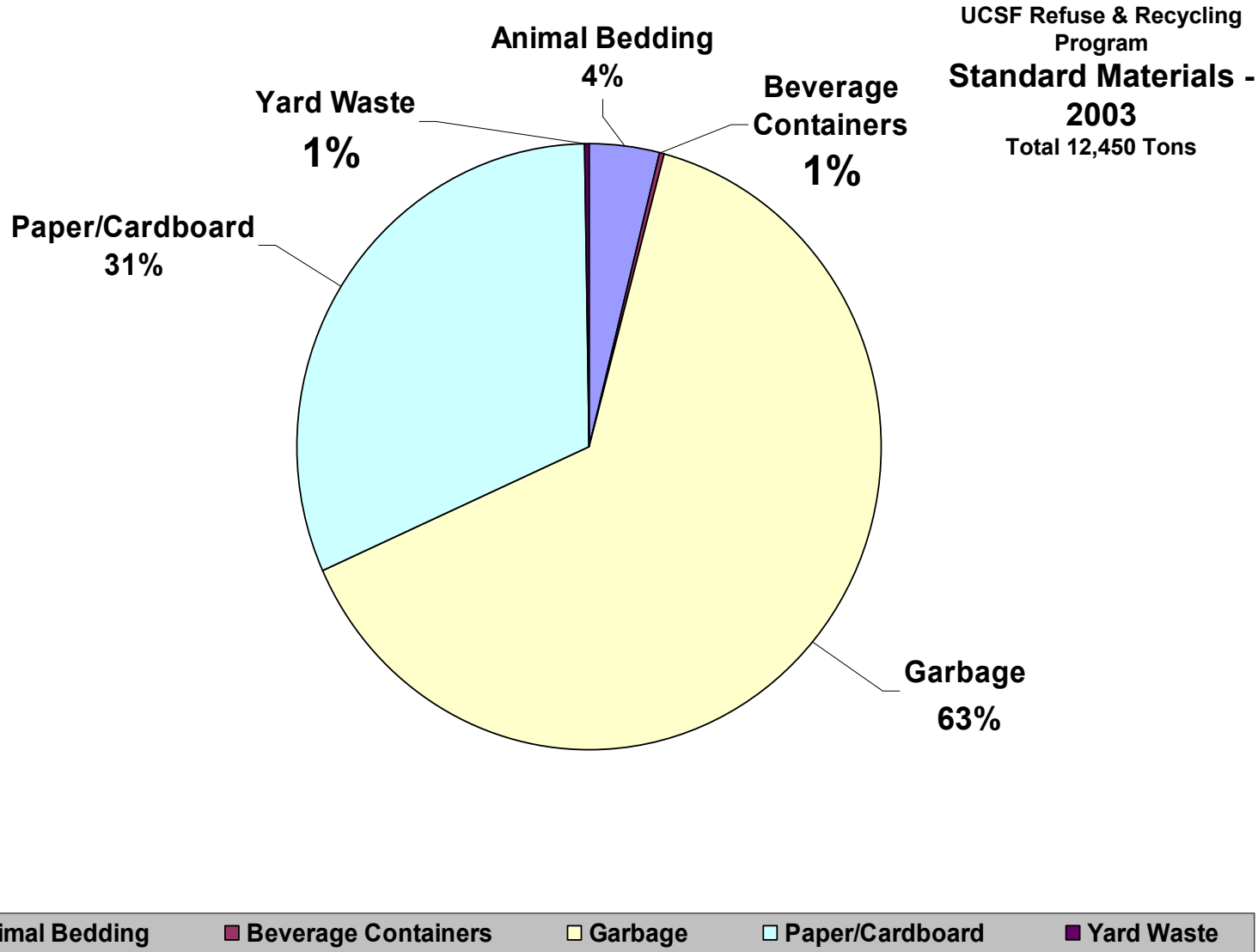
2000 – 2002

Expanded Recycling Program begins for green waste and animal bedding as compost, which includes fluorescent light bulbs, toner, cartridges, and computer parts recovery

2003 – Present

Recycling Program has now expanded to include Bulky Item Collection Days, Battery Recycling, Construction Material Recovery, Abandoned Materials Pilot Project, Pipette Box Recycling Begins, Green Building Lectures Series
