This first update has a number of items regarding staffing of the new HRB organization:

Organization Chart Update

The organization chart on the [HRB Restructuring website](#) has been updated to reflect the most recent changes. This includes names of the two newly announced Executive Directors and the MSP reassignments. It also includes several Programmer Analyst positions that have been reassigned. We will continue to update the chart as new positions are posted and filled so that you can see our new organization take shape.

New Jobs Posted

With the announcement that Mike Baptista as Executive Director of Quality Assurance and Compliance, his current position as Director of Information Systems Support is open. That job is being posted this week as are several programmer analyst positions.

UCSF HR Jobs

As Judy Boyette mentioned in her message last week, as a result of our affiliation with UCSF HR, UCSF HR is adding a number of new jobs. These jobs will be open only to current UCSF HR employees and all HRB employees. The UCOP HR director position is currently posted on CATS, and the other positions, which are all PSS positions, will be posted when we post our PSS positions later this month. HRB Layoff Plan Pending Approval

As Katie Lapp mentioned in her message to OP staff on Friday, HR&B has been asked to submit a layoff plan to UCOP Human Resources for approval. HR&B has complied with this request: our plan has been submitted and is pending approval. After it is approved, we will be able to share more information with you.
