Changes in staffing levels at UC reflect growth in enrollment, research activity and health science services have been accompanied by a long term-trend toward increased professionalization of the workforce. Between 2007-08 and 2015-16, enrollment grew by 15%, research expenditures (through 2014-15) grew by an inflation-adjusted 9% and medical center expenditures (through 2014-15) grew by an inflation-adjusted 46%.
