\* Proposed fee level represents an increase of 5.3% after taking into account the inclusion of additional units in the program beginning 2017-18. Continuing students who entered in 2016-17 will pay the same fee (\$60,756) in 2017-18. New students in 2017-18 will pay a program fee of \$73,806, which covers the additional costs for extending the program from 13.5 months to 15 months (52 units to 60 units).

\*\*Differential fees for resident and nonresident students in this program is an exception to policy approved only for the initial transition period from state-supported to self-supporting status. Fees for resident and nonresident students must be the same starting the 2018-19 academic year.
