





UC chancellors place among the lowest-paid when compared to their Association

of American Universities (AAU) peers despite recent UC salary increases

With the recently published updated compensation data for public institution leaders,

from the previous analysis in June 2015 despite recent salary increases approved in July 2016. Nine UC chancellor salaries fall among the lowest third in this comparison

group. UC San Francisco, an exclusively graduate health science campus, is the only


exception. Eight UC chancellors are among the ten lowest-paid leaders within this

UC chancellors received 3 percent salary increases compared to AAU averages:

Private – 10 and 16 percent (base and total compensation, respectively)
