ANNUAL REPORT ON COMPENSATED OUTSIDE PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2010: INCUMBENTS IN SENIOR MANAGEMENT POSITIONS

Attached is the annual report, for calendar year 2010, of compensated Outside Professional Activities (OPA) of members of the Senior Management Group (SMG).

As stated in the Senior Management Group Outside Professional Activities policy (Regents Policy 7707), approved by the Regents in January 2010:

"...Considerable benefit accrues to the University from Senior Management Group (SMG) members' association with external educational and research institutions, not-for-profit professional associations, federal, state and local government offices and private sector organizations. Such associations foster a greater understanding of the University of California and its value as a preeminent provider of education, research, public service, and health care. Such associations also may provide a stimulus for economic development and enhanced economic competitiveness."

Consistent with the policy on Senior Management Group Outside Professional Activities, section III.B.3.a.ii states:

"An SMG member will be required to use his/her personal time to engage in compensated Outside Professional Activities, by either performing such activities outside his/her usual work hours or debiting accrued vacation time consistent with applicable leave policy."

Report Highlights

The attached report reflects the individually certified declarations of every member of the SMG regarding their compensated OPA that occurred in calendar year 2010. SMG members who separated from the University prior to January 1, 2011 and individuals who only served in SMG positions in an acting capacity are not included in this report. Compensated OPA that occurred prior to 2010, or prior to the SMG member's appointment to their SMG position, are not included in the report. If activities were inadvertently omitted from the 2009 compensated OPA report they would have been included in this report, but there were no such omissions.

Following the individual certification by SMG members, the Chancellors, Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory Director and the Division and Department Heads of the Office of the President certified their reports as to the inclusion of all SMG members meeting the aforementioned criteria.

Due to the transfer of the academic deans out of the SMG population on January 1, 2010, the population of the report changed from 102 reporting compensated activity in 2009 to 50 reporting compensated activity in 2010. The academic deans will report their OPA on a separate report.

This report as reviewed by the Office of Ethics, Compliance & Audit Services for compliance with policies governing this area, to ensure there are no conflicts of interest, or conflicts of commitment.
