Definition Statement:
(1-12)
There is a need for a UC-wide employee ID, primarily to assist in intercampus transfers and other intercampus activities. This ID could be in addition to the campus-defined employee ID. The UC UDIR project established a 10-character netID that could be used for this purpose; it is created at UCOP and is available to campuses.

Comments/Risk Factors:
The use of the UDIR netID in addition to (rather than instead of) employee ID would allow campuses to continue their methods of assigning IDs, particularly where campuses have combined employee and student IDs. This approach would also allow a transition at a later time to a single UC-wide employee ID.

Programming Assumptions:
This need could be met by populating an existing P/PS field with data from UCOP on a regular basis (such as nightly), displaying it on selected screens and reports, and passing it to data warehouses as appropriate.
