REPORT

The Ad Hoc met several times by conference call during the fall. To address numbers 1,5, and 6 in the Charge below, the group has decided to survey the membership. As a result the group has been developing a survey instrument to gather information from the different stakeholder groups. The group is currently exploring the feasibility of an electronic survey.

The results of the survey will then provide information for the group to address numbers 2,3, and 4 of the Charge.

The Ad hoc asked for and was granted an extension of its final reporting deadline from 2005 Fall Assembly to 2006 Spring Assembly.

The Charge

The Committee is conferred broad authority to research the overall environment affecting librarian instructional roles in order to prepare a report that provides recommendations regarding the following:

1. Reviewing the instruction services that Librarians provide
2. Including the impact of departmental, campus and system-wide policies and practices
3. Investigating and analyzing issues surrounding librarian instructional activities
4. Considering the role of the APM
5. Consulting broadly with the membership
6. Gathering information from library administrators, faculty members, lecturers, and academic human resources professionals as needed
