

Statewide Collection Development Committee  
Report for the 2006 Fall Assembly

As LAUC representative on the statewide Collection Development Committee, I participated at the monthly three hour conference calls as well as the quarterly in-person meetings in Oakland.

CDC continued discussing details of the yearly negotiations with online resource vendors. The permanent, sometimes unjustified price increase causes problems against which the UC libraries have to find their own strategy. The committee discussed the annual reports to CDC from the Bibliographer Groups, Archivists Council and Preservation Advisory Groups. Shared Print and questions of journal print archives (like JSTOR) stayed in the focus of the discussions. UCSC submitted and CDC discussed a general proposal for a retrospective shared print archive. These projects would help UC libraries solving their space problems as well as to build a safe print archive to some major online journal resources.
