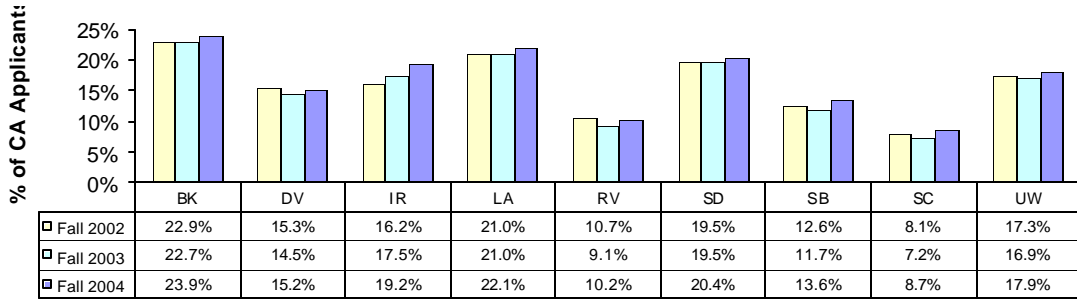

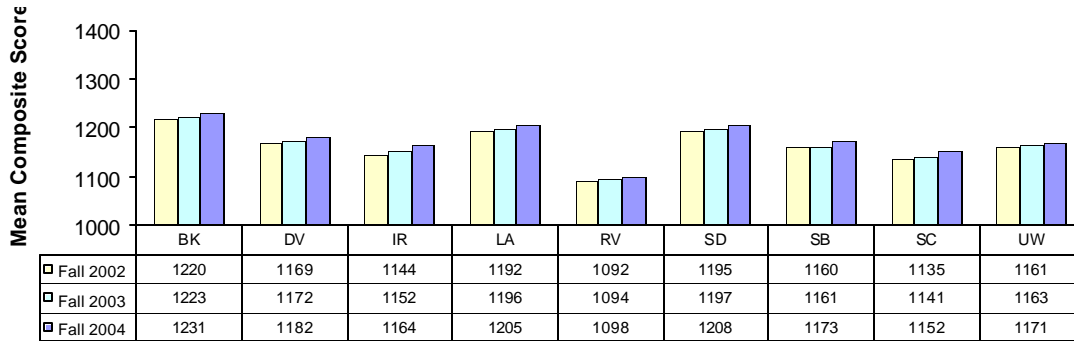

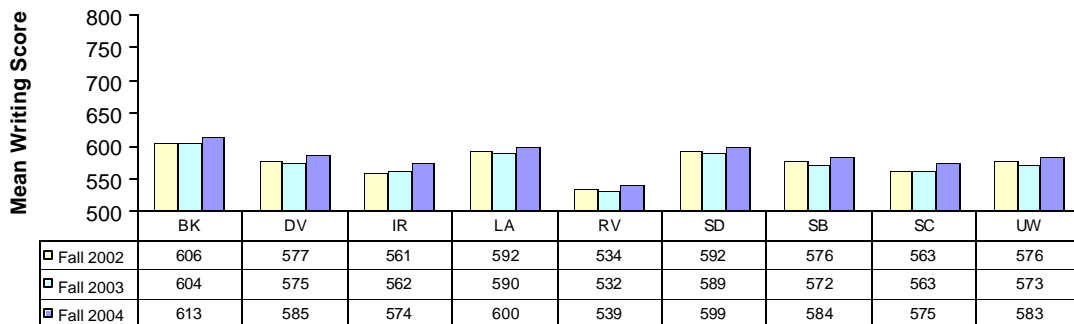

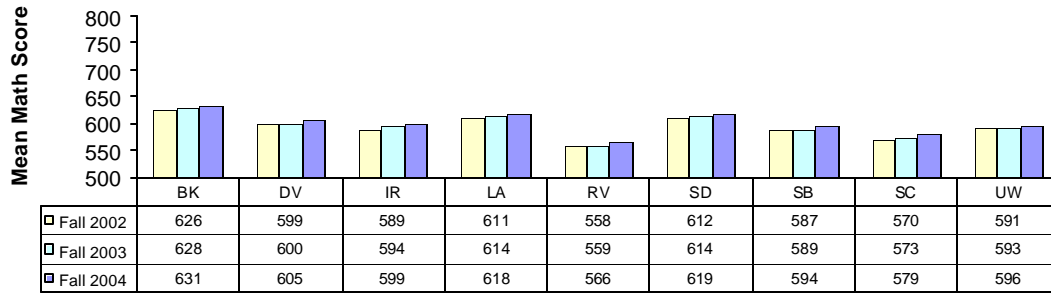
SAT I Composite



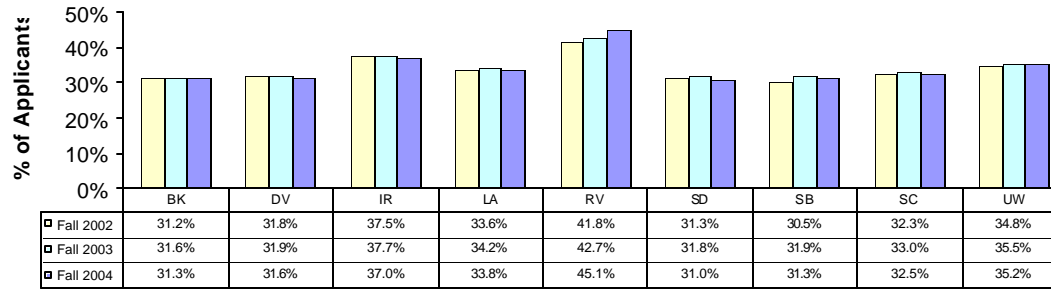

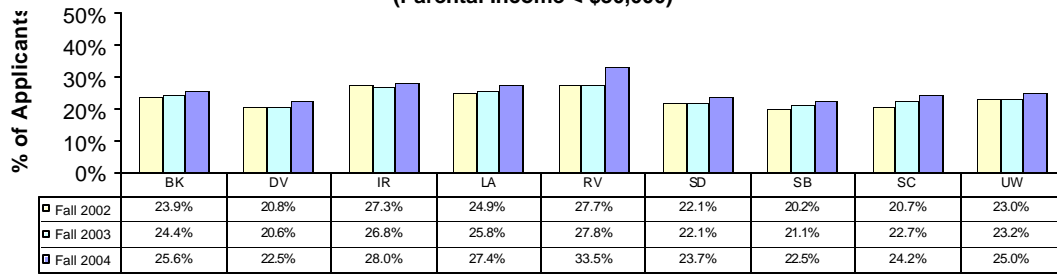
SAT II Math (Highest)



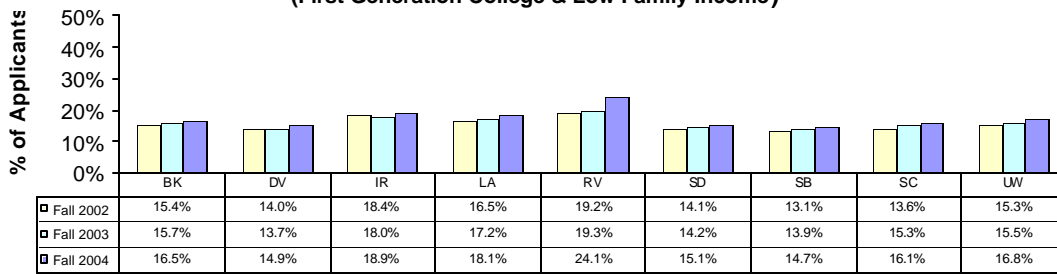

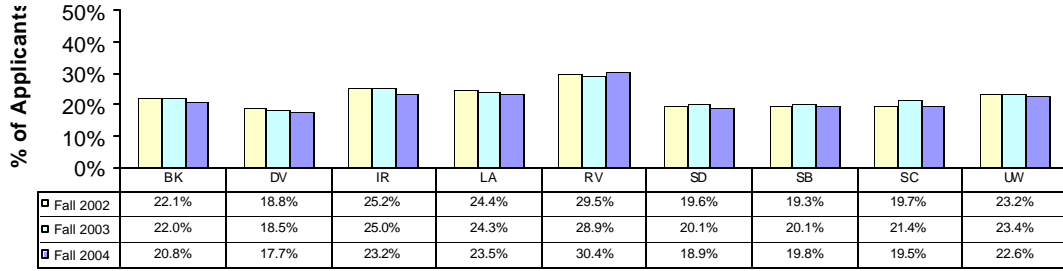
**Low Family Income
(Parental Income < \$30,000)**



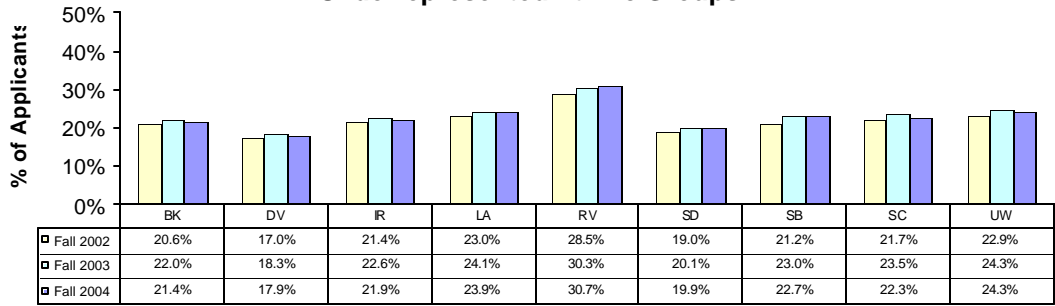

(First Generation College & Low Family Income)**



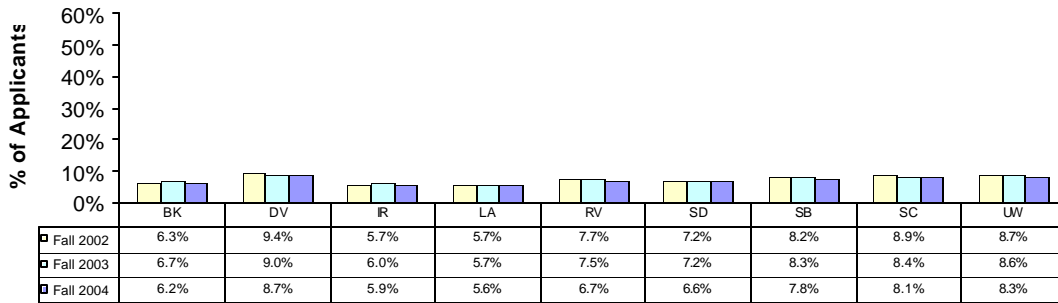

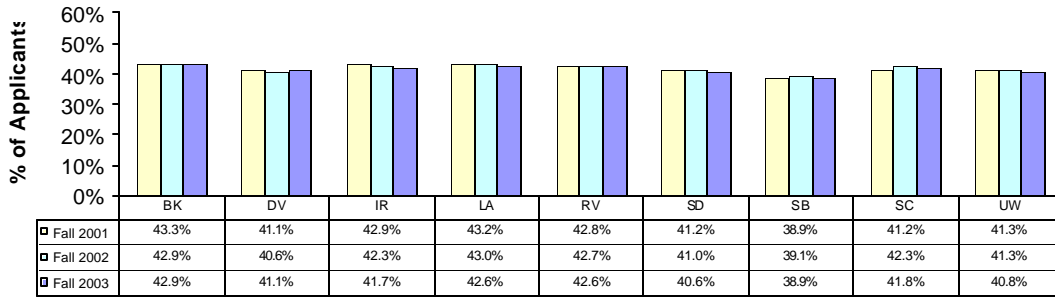
