(1) Data are from the UCAP files of 5/31/07 for Fall 2007, 6/3/08 for Fall 2008 and 5/28/09 for Fall 2009.

(2) Latinos represent 23% of the admitted Chicano/Latino group for 2009.

(3) For 2007 and 2008, the Asian American category includes applicants who declared themselves as Chinese, East Indian/Pakistani, Japanese, Korean, Vietnamese, and other Asian. For 2009, the category includes applicants who declared themselves as Asian Indian, Bangladeshi, Cambodian, Chinese, Hmong, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Malaysian, Pakistani, Sri Lankan, Taiwanese, Thai, Vietnamese, and other Asian.

(4) For 2007 and 2008, the Pacific Islander category was broadly defined. The drop seen for 2009 may be due to the more narrowly defined categories of Fijian, Guamanian/Chamorro, Hawaiian, Samoan, Tongan, and other Pacific Islander as well as options for applicants to declare themselves as one of the new Asian categories.

(5) Decline to state includes students who did not provide information on their ethnic identity in the admission application.

(6) UC Merced and UC Riverside figures include freshmen who were referred to the campus because they were not offered admission at one of the campuses to which they originally applied. Referral admits for Fall 2009 represent 60% and 34% of total admits to Merced and Riverside, respectively. Fall 2009 SIR rates for freshmen who applied directly to these campuses (excluding referral students) are 14.6% for UC Merced and 24.2% for UC Riverside.

(7) International students are excluded in this report.
