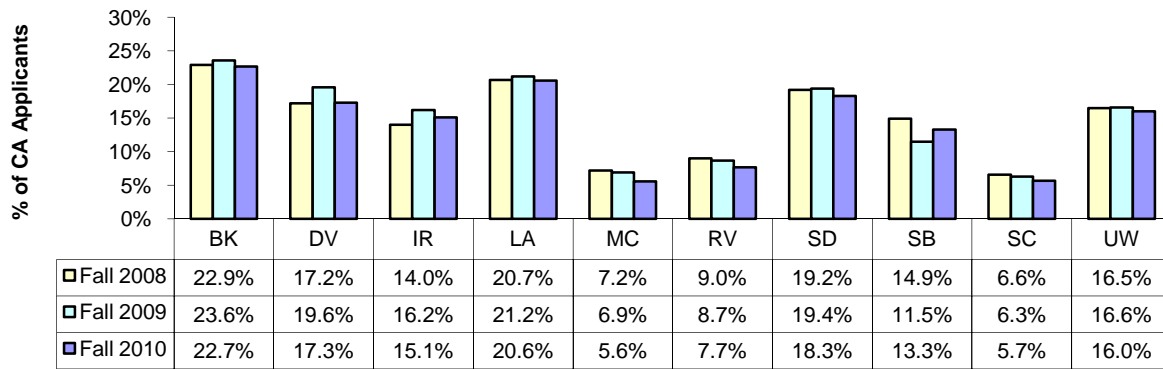

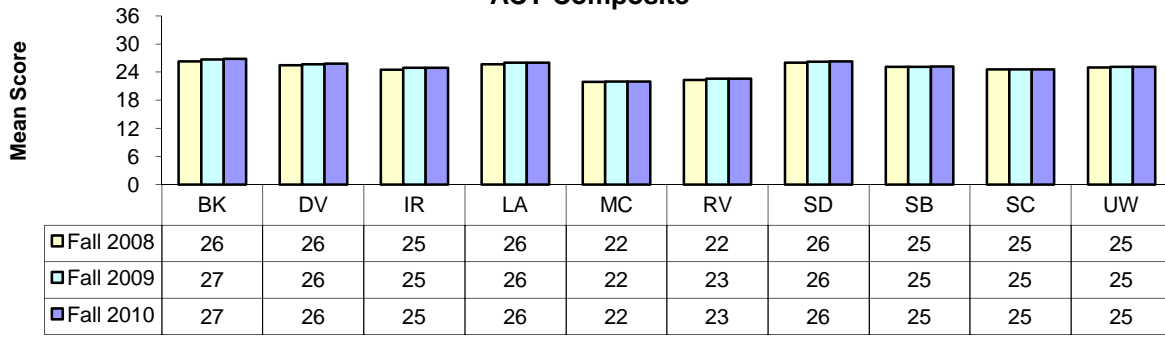

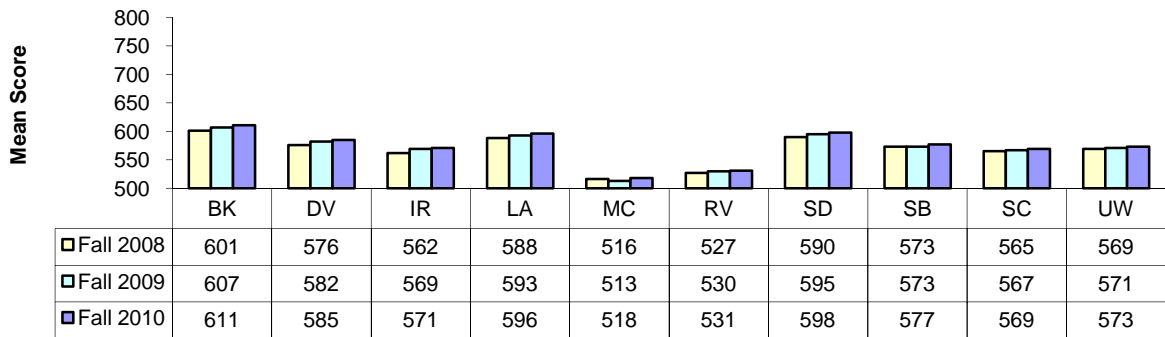
**ACT Composite<sup>4</sup>**



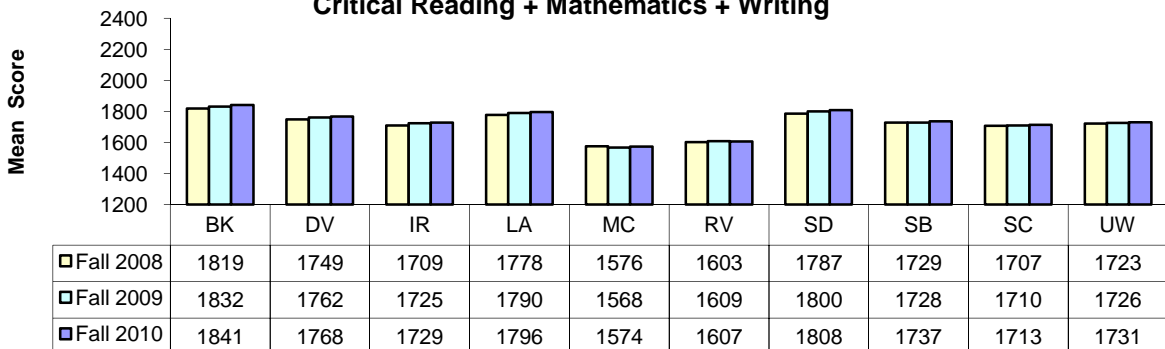
**SAT Reasoning:

**SAT Reasoning: Writing**

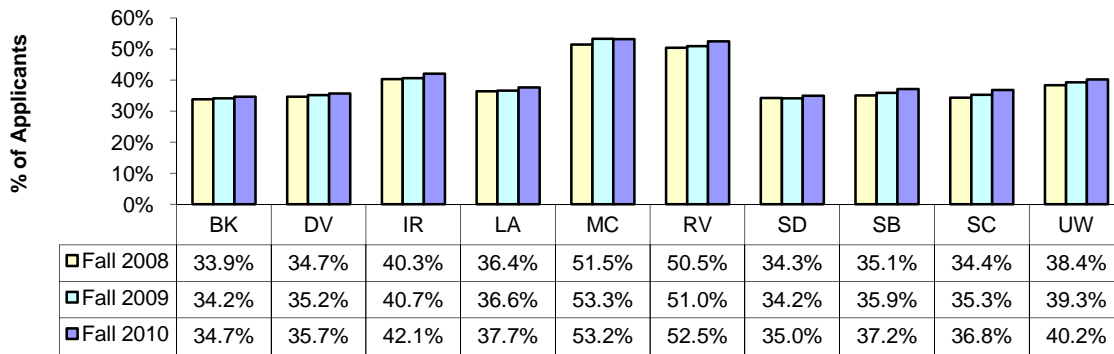


**SAT Reasoning Total:  
Critical Reading + Mathematics + Writing**

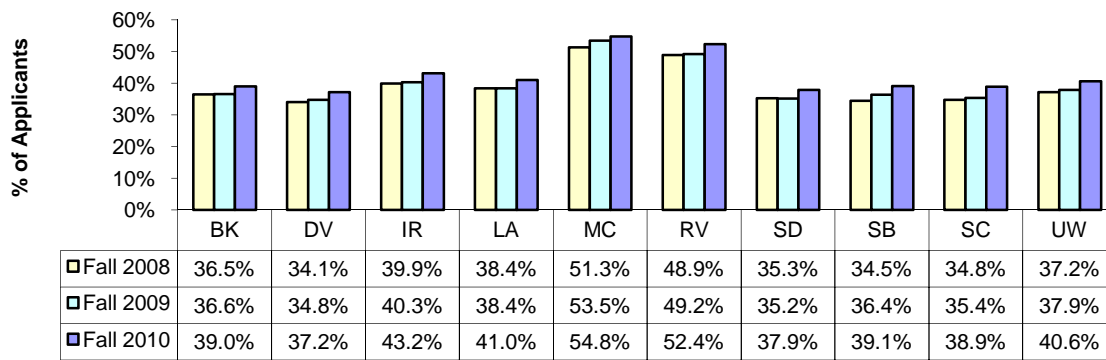

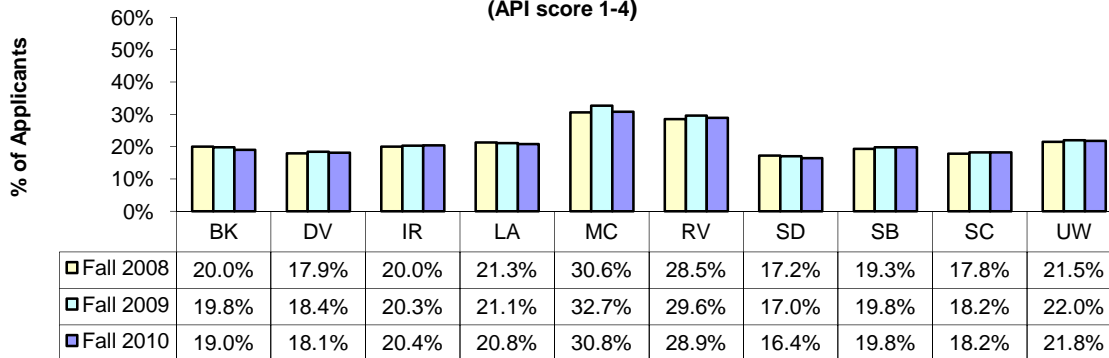
**First Generation College<sup>5</sup>**



**Low Family Income<sup>6</sup>**

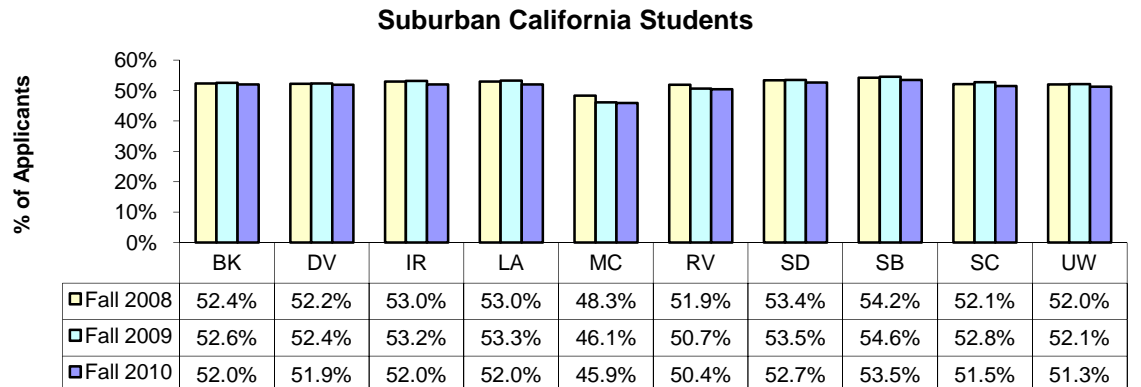
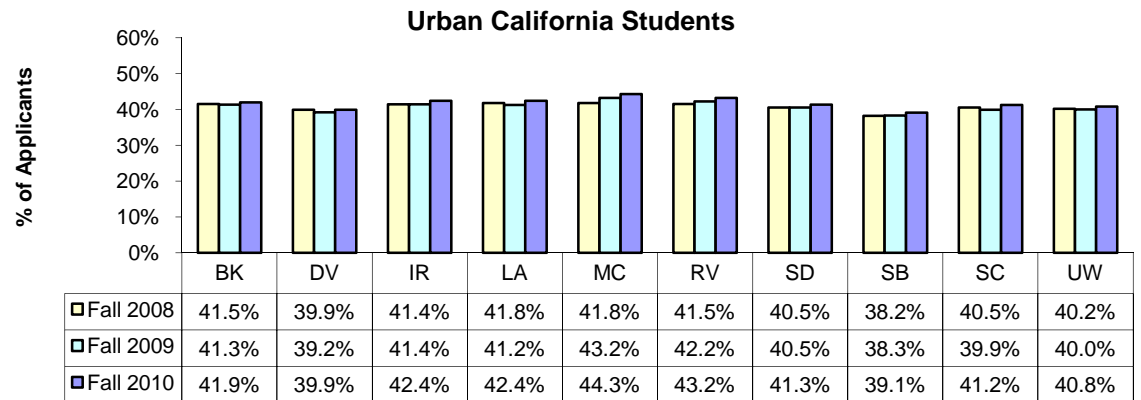
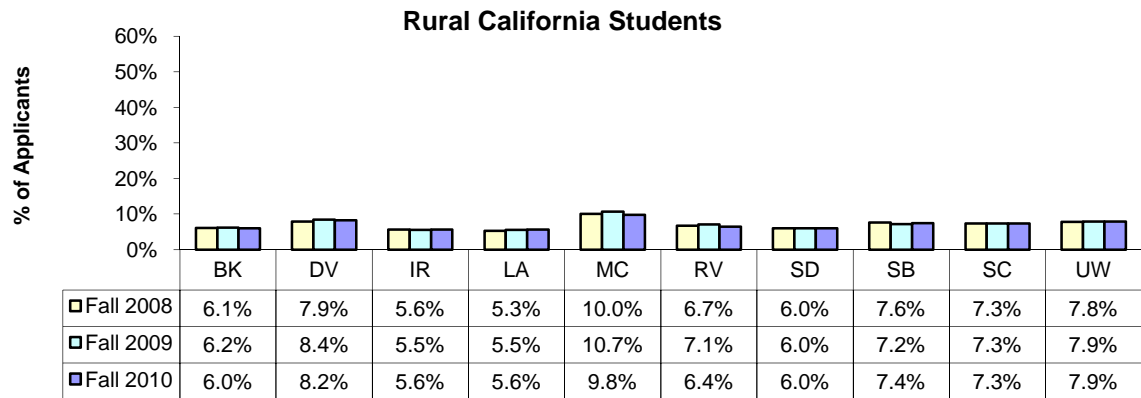
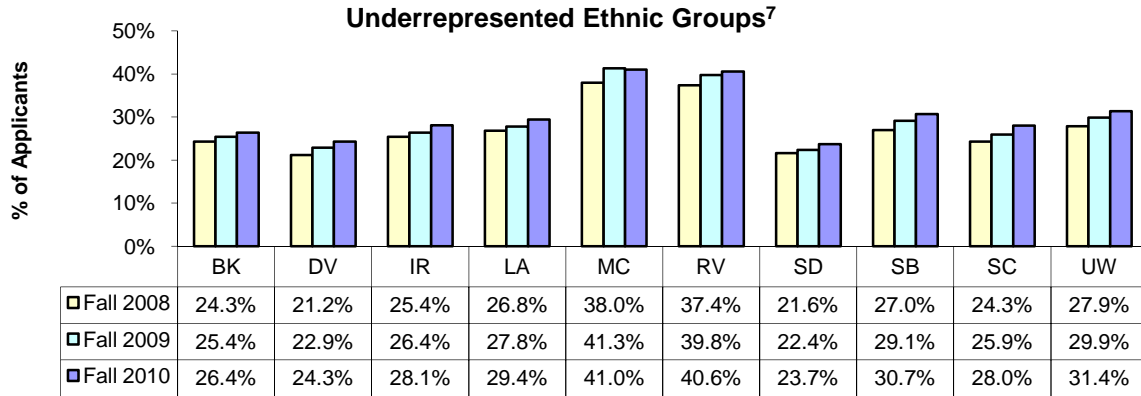


**Low High School API
