For 2009 and 2010, the category includes applicants who declared themselves as Asian Indian, Bangladeshi, Cam Indonesian, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Malaysian, Pakistani, Sri Lankan, Taiwanese, Thai, Vietnamese, and other Asian.

(3) For 2008, the Pacific Islander was a single broadly defined category. For 2009 and 2010, the Pacific Islander category includes: Fijian, Guamanian/Chamorro, Hawaiian, Samoan, Tongan, and as well as other Pacific Islander.

(4) Decline to state include students who did not provide information on their ethnic identity in the admission application.

(5) In 2010 the race/ethnicity survey does not include Other as a category.
