Dear Colleagues:

At their November 1998 meeting, The Regents delegated authority to the President to set fees for self-supporting degree programs. Consistent with that delegation, I approved fee levels as shown on the enclosed pages.

These fees are effective fall 2013 unless otherwise noted, and may include both program fees and any additional campus-based fees, except health insurance. The approved fees are based on documentation submitted by your campuses. A report summarizing the approved fee levels for self-supporting programs at all the campuses will be provided to The Regents, consistent with their November 1998 action.

As provided in University policy, annual revenue from each program must be sufficient to cover all direct and indirect costs for the program to be self-supporting. As part of the process to approve fee increases, your campus will be asked to provide expenditure data for each program on an annual basis.
