Service Request 80286

Service Request 80238 addressed the requirements for modifications to support the new Health Care Reimbursement Account (HCRA) program. Service Request 80251 addressed the requirements for modifications to support the modified Dependent Care assistance program. These modifications were issued in Release 1440.

Both HCRA and DepCare are managed by an outside vendor, SHPS. Service Request 80286 requested that modifications be made to provide SHPS with HCRA and DepCare enrollment and activity data. A file will be produced twice a month, and transmitted via FTP to UCOP. At UCOP the files will be consolidated and transmitted to SHPS.

Programs

PPOT1458 (one-time)

PPOT1458 is a one-time program which will process the DB2 PAR and insert initial rows into the new PPPSHP table for each existing PPPPIR row. The PPPSHP rows will control what PAR data is processed in each pass by PPP466. Rows with a Pay Cycle Check Date in 2003 will have a SHPS File Indicator 'N' which will cause them to be processed by the first run of new program PPP466. Rows with a Pay Cycle Check Date prior to 2003 will have a SHPS File Indicator 'Y' which will cause them to be bypassed by PPP466.

PPP465

PPP465 is the main driver program for loading the DB2 PAR. It has been modified to insert matching rows into the PPPSHP table each time a PPPPIR row is inserted. The SHPS File Indicator is set to 'N'.

PPP466 (new)

PPP466 is a new program to create the SHPS file. It reports any employee who is either enrolled in HCRA or DepCare on the EDB, or who had deduction activity for HCRA or DepCare on the PAR data that is processed by PPP466. It will be scheduled to run twice a month. Each time the PPPSHP table will be used to bypass PAR data that has already been processed. However, regardless of PAR activity or not, enrolled employees will be reported on every file.

Copymembers

CPWSSHPS (new)

CPWSSHPS is a new copymember to define working storage for the SHPS file Header, Employee and Trailer records.

Include Members

PPPVZSHP (new)

PPPVZSHP is a new Include member to define working storage for the whole table view of the new PPPSHP table.

DDL Members

TSSHP00C (new)

TSSHP00C creates the tablespace for the new table PPPSHP.

TBSHP00C (new)

TBSHP00C creates the table for the new table PPPSHP.

IXSHP00C (new)

IXSHP00C creates the index for the new table PPPSHP.

PPPVZSHP (new)

PPPVZSHP creates the view for the new table PPPSHP.

Bind Members

PPOT1458 (one-time)

PPOT1458 is the plan bind for one-time program PPOT1458.

PPP466 (new)

PPP466 is the plan bind for new program PPP466.
