This release addresses the following Service Request:

Service Request 16913 - New Action Codes for Across the Board Wage Increase

UC Human Resources and Benefits (HR&B) has requested that two new Action Code values be established in the Payroll/Personnel System (PPS) to reflect employee wage increases that are applied across the board. A separate project is underway to develop a process to apply across the board wage increases using the on-line "merit" facility. This process will generate the new value '55' action code which will be formatted to an EDB update transaction file along with the wage adjustment transactions, and input at the campus into a batch EDB file maintenance run. The '55' value would also be used by any one-time programs used to effect across the board wage increases. Code value '54' was established to allow users manual entry as necessary, but not intended for a batch update process.

Detail Design

General

The two new codes will be added to the list of allowable values for the elements EDB 2047, EDB 2063 and EDB 2064. These are the data elements for the action codes for a distribution. This will allow the code 54 to be entered on-line and code 55 to be used in batch maintenance. Code 54 will be added to CICS HELP. Both codes will be added to the list of codes allowable on the CPS Interface file. These codes will also generate cost activity. In general, they will be treated similarly to the merit and range codes.

Copy Members - modified

CPWSXICC

The codes 54 and 55 were added to lists of valid staff, academic and management action codes. These lists are used by PPP960 in processing Cost Transactions.

CPWSXIC2

The Action Codes 54 and 55 were added to IDC-VALID-STAFF-ACTION which is used by **PPCTCSTE** to allow entries to the CST Costing, table used by the Costing processing.

The code 54 was added to IDC-VALID-ACTION-APPT for **PPP700**. As this program creates Cost transactions it checks for changes to certain data on the distribution. For actions listed under IDC-VALID-ACTION-APPT, the appointment is checked also for certain changes. The manual codes for merit and range appear in this list.

The code 55 was added to IDC-INVALID-COST-ACTION used by **PPP700** in order to stop the creation of cost transactions for action 55 because those will have been created by a previous job. This is similar to the manner in which merits, action 27, are handled.

Budget codes 6 and 7 (academic and staff) were added to BUDGET-JOURNAL-NUMBERS-ACTION list for both 54 and 55. These are used by **PPP980** in creating budget journal transactions. These are the same codes used for the range actions, codes 33 and 28.

Programs - modified

PPACTION - Dual - ACT update program

Code was added to update the ACT action table for codes 54 and 55. The action effective date on the ACT row is set to the *pay begin date* found on the distribution.

PPHRMGR - CICS Function IHHR - Prints the *History Data Base Report*

Codes 54 and 55 with their descriptions (documentation only) were added to the list of possible action codes that print on the history report. This program reads the ATN table (history of all actions) and prints all actions on the report. The descriptions are accessed from the CTT, Code Translation Table.

PPP700 - Batch - Creates Cost Transactions from input ECF file(s) for manual distribution actions.

This program was affected by modifications to copylib **CPWSXIC2** described above. In addition, modifications were made to this program so that in the case of a 54 action code for an *academic*, a cost transaction will be created. Previously, unless the action was a 33, manual range adjustment, a transaction was not created for an academic.

PPP710 - Batch - Produces the CPS/BCS Interface file

Codes 54 and 55 were added to the list of action codes to be passed on the interface file.

PPP960 - Batch - Merges costing files from various sources into one costing file.

This program produces a control report with total transactions by type. An accumulator and report entry were added to the report for action code 55 and code 54 was added to the PAF group where the other manual distribution action codes are accumulated.

PPP990 - Batch - Produces reports from all phases of the costing programs.

Code 55 was added to the "range" action class and code 54 was added to the "miscellaneous" action class. This will cause the ATB activity to be reported on the same report as the "range" actions 28 and 33.

PPWHADC - CICS Function HADC - Displays the *Appt./Dist. History - Compact*

Codes 54 and 55 with their descriptions (documentation only) were added to the list of action codes that display on this screen. A maximum of 3 actions can be displayed so there is a priority associated with each action code. The priorities for 54 and 55 are 3 and 4 respectively right after the highest priorities for the 2 merit action codes.

PPWHADF - CICS Function HADF - Displays the *Appt./Dist. History - Full*

Codes 54 and 55 with their descriptions (documentation only) were added to the list of action codes that display on this screen. A maximum of 3 actions can be displayed so there is a priority associated with each action code. The priorities for 54 and 55 are 3 and 4 respectively. The highest priorities are for the 2 merit action codes 04 and 27.

CICS Help Changes

EDB2047, EDB2063 and EDB2064

These are *modified* help files with code 54 added to the list of available action codes which may be entered on the EAPP (Appointments and Distributions) and EAPC (Appt./Distributions-Condense) screens.

Table Changes

Data Element Table

For elements 2047, 2063 and 2064, the codes 54 and 55 were added as allowable values.

Code Translation Table

Entries were added for 54 and 55 in order to provide descriptions for these codes when this table is used for obtaining action code descriptions.

Web Application Modifications

UCWALST - ucwactionslist.d2w of WMACRO is a list of action codes for the PAN notification selection screen. The new action code 54 (Manual ATB Wage Increase) was added to the list of codes displayed.

Timing of Installation

The installation of this release is Not Urgent.
