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Load DB2 CTL Database (LOADCTL)

Load the DB2 CTL.

The PPPDOS table contains DOS Code DIS which is not Regular Pay. Distributions with this DOS can exclude an appointment from UCRP consideration; however, if Regular Pay DOS Codes also exist for the appointment it will be considered. DOS Code REG is of course Regular Pay.

The Title Code Table contains Title Code 1501 with a Retirement Code 1 = 0. Appointments with this Title Code are excluded from UCRP consideration. Title Code 4672 on the other hand has Retirement Code 1 = 1, which allows it to be considered.

Verification

Confirm the job ran to successful completion.

Load DB2 EDB Database (LOADEDDB)

Load the DB2 EDB.

Confirm the job ran to successful completion.

A PPP2501 report is printed of the test cases for the one-time program.

The SCR Current Date is 03/01/2003. This date controls the past, current and future designation for appointments for PPFICRET. Minimally, a full year of 50% Appointment Percentage for a current appointment is required for UCRP enrollment. Other factors also control the final result.

One-Time Derivation of Students for UCRP (RUNOT)

This job executes the one-time program PPOT1481, which selects all employees who are students (Student Status 3, 4, 6, 7) and calls the release version of PPFICRET for possible re-derivation of their Retirement Code, FICA Code and UI Code.

The one-time can be run in both non-update and update mode, per the Run Specification record. The reports and ECF are created in either mode.

Verification

Confirm the job ran to successful completion. The results discussed here are for UPDATE mode. If running in REPORT mode, the reports and ECF should be the same, but the PPP2501 report will not indicate any changes.

The OT14811 report displays the re-derivation changes for each employee that had a change to at least one of the three codes. The report should break on a change in Home Department. Confirm that ID 33333018 is on a separate department report.

The OT14812 report indicates what mode was requested. Error messages, such as resulting from a missing Run Specification Record or an SQL -818, would also be printed to this file.

The PPP1800 report from the ECF should reflect the same changes as indicated in the OT14811 report.

A PPP2501 report is printed of the test cases. Confirm that the changes reflected in the OT14811 report and PPP1800 report are now reported from the EDB as well.

Student Status 7, 60% Appointment, Retirement/FICA Derivation Indicator = R, Ret/FICA/UI is N/N/N. No re-derivation.

Student Status 6, 50% Appointment with no distribution, regular pay assumed, registered units less than minimum, Ret/FICA/UI is H/M/C. Re-derivation to U/E/C.

Student Status 4, 50% Appointment 1501 and 50% Appointment 4672, Ret/FICA/UI is N/N/N. Re-derivation to U/E/C.

Online Testing

This testing confirms that PPFICRET is correctly deriving UCRP, FICA and UI Codes for students. It also shows that the Student Status edit has been removed from PPEC101.

Verification

Select an employee that has Student Status 3, 4, 6 or 7 and manipulate the Student Status, Appointment Percentage, DOS Codes on Distribution or no distributions, Title Codes with Retirement Code 1 = zero or 1, and Retirement/FICA Indicators to create the various combinations tested in the one-time program test. Confirm the results in each case, consistent with the one-time results.

Perform a New Hire with Student Status 3, 4, 6 or 7 with 50% valid UCRP appointment. Confirm UCRP enrollment.

Perform a New Hire with Student Status 3, 4, 6 or 7 with a less than 50% valid UCRP appointment. Confirm UCRP enrollment did not occur; N or H should be derived for retirement.

Confirm that message 08-123 is not issued by PPEC054 for test cases in which an employee with Student Status 3, 4, 6 or 7 is being derived into UCRP.
