This release addresses the following service request and error report:

Service Request 80534

It is asked that the Merit Roster Process (PPP670) be modified so that Professional and Support Staff (PSS) rosters no longer exclude portions of the population depending on the month of the effective date entered on the Specification Run record.

Release 1083 modified the Merit Roster Process to recognize the new Personnel Program Code (EDB 2007) values, introduced as part of the Human Resources Management Initiative (HRMI) to replace the former four tier staff personnel program. The HRMI project collapsed the existing four staff tiers into two groups: Professional and Support Staff, made up of 'Administration and Professional Staff' (A&PS) and 'Staff' titles; and Management and Senior Professional, comprised of the 'Executive' and 'Management and Professional' (MAP) groups.

Because non-A&PS titles were not eligible for merit increases in October, Release 1083 included logic to restrict the eligible population for PSS rosters based on the month of the effective as entered on the Specification Run record. However, this is no longer valid. Service Request 80534 asks that the Merit Roster Process be modified so that PSS rosters (where roster type of '1' is specified on Specification Run record) include the entire eligible population, including both former A&PS and Staff titles, regardless of the month of the effective date entered on the Specification Run record.

Error Report 1868

Depending on the call type to PPTCTUTL, the PPPTSB table is accessed to retrieve the data values in columns TSB-EFFECTIVE, TSB-END-DATE, TSB-RANGE-ADJ-ID, TSB-NO-STEPS, TSB-PAY-INTRVRLS, and TSB-

MERIT-BASED. The logic in paragraph 90085-LOAD-TSB-DATA moves the TSB data to the linkage as defined in copymember CPLNKTCL. However, the data for TSB-MERIT-BASED was not moved to the linkage, resulting in a blank Merit Based value returned to the calling program.

Programs

PPP670

This program has been modified to include both former A&PS and Staff titles on the PSS rosters, regardless of the month of the effective date entered on the Specification Run record. Code in paragraph SFS-SELECT-FORMER-APS is no longer applicable, and has been commented out.

PPTCTUTL

This utility program has been modified to move the Merit Based value to the linkage defined in copymember CPLNKTCL.

Test Plan

At UCOP a before and after test were performed. No formal test materials are released. Campuses can replicate the following steps to test PPP670.

1. The unmodified version of PPP670 is run with the following values entered on the Specification Run record. **Note that an effective month of '10' is entered in columns 11 through 12.**

The PPP6702 report displayed the detail for those employees with former APS Title Codes.

2. The unmodified version of PPP670 is run again with the following values entered on the Specification Run record. **Note that an effective month of '07' is entered in columns 11 through 12.**

The PPP6702 report displayed the detail for those employees with Staff Title Codes.

3. The modified version of PPP670 is run with the following values entered on the Specification Run record. **Note that an effective month of '10' is entered in columns 11 through 12.**

The PPP6702 report displayed the detail for those employees with former A&PS Title Codes and Staff Title Codes. It is verified that the PPP6702 report displayed the entire eligible population of employees with former A&PS Title Codes from step 1, and employees with Staff Title Code from step 2 above.

4. The modified version of PPP670 is run again with the following values entered on the Specification Run record. **Note that an effective month of '07' is entered in columns 11 through 12.**

The PPP6702 report displayed the same detail as the PPP6702 report in step 3 above.

Installation Instructions

1. Program Preparation

At UCOP, all COBOL programs pass through the DB2 pre-compiler, whether or not the program contains embedded SQL, to resolve INCLUDE references. Your site may have different requirements.

Note: "DUAL" programs must be compiled twice and linked into batch and online libraries ("LOADLIB" and "OLOADLIB" respectively), and DUAL-ONLINE programs must be compiled once only and linked into the online library. "CICS" programs must be CICS pre-compiled and compiled once and linked into OLOADLIB. "Batch" programs must be compiled once and linked into the batch LOADLIB only.

Note: The "SPAS" designation indicates that a module needs to be compile and linked into the appropriate SPAS loadlib. If only "SPAS" is indicated in the Compile column, then the module is either a called procedure, or only called by a stored procedure. The SPAS package bind differs from that used for CICS dual-use binds. If the SPAS application is running, a STOP and START PROCEDURE is required to install the new version.

a) Install, compile and link the **modified** programs listed in the following table:

Perform installation verification testing as described in the Test Plan above.

Perform any desired additional campus testing.

4. Install objects into production.

Timing of Installation

The installation of this release is Urgent.

This release must be installed for the next scheduled run of PPP670 to produce the PSS (Professional and Support Staff) rosters (where roster type = '1' in column 16 of Specification Run record), so that the entire eligible population including both former A&PS and Staff titles are selected, regardless of the month of the effective date entered on the Specification Run record.
