

SR 81412: Add Grade Type to CPS Interface

The 2-character 'Grade Type' value from the Title Code Table (TCT) should be added to the Appointment Record segment of the CPS Interface File (PPP712), as shown on the attached file layout.

The program should query the TCT for a match on the sub-location and Pay Representation (UNC/COV) segment for the appointment Title Code. If a match is found and the TCT Rate Lookup Code = 'G' ('Graded'), the 'Grade Type' value should be included on the interface file in the indicated position. Otherwise, the field should be left blank.
