SR81218 Employee WOS Indicator to CPS Interface

The Employee Level Without Salary Indicator (EDB 0778) should be added to the monthly CPS Interface File in position 408.

SR81412 Add Grade Type to CPS Interface

The 2-character 'Grade Type' value from the Title Code Table (TCT) should be added to the Appointment Record segment of the CPS Interface File (from program PPP712).

For Title Codes where the TCT Rate Lookup Code = 'G' ('Graded'), the 'Grade Type' value should be included on the interface file in the indicated position. Otherwise, the field should be left blank.

Programs

PPP711

PPP711 performs a monthly extract of EDB and Dependent data. Column EMP_WOS_IND currently exists in the PER database table.

PPP711 has been modified such that the database column named EMP_WOS_IND is extracted to position 408 of the Employee level extract record (previously filler).

PPP712

PPP712 performs the extract of Appointment Data as a feed to Corporate Personnel System. The grade type currently exists in the APP table and is accessible using the PCTCTUTL subprogram. Modifications were made to access the grade type from the PCTCTUTL program and add it to the beginning of the current filler area at the end

of the record (CPWSXACP). Modifications were made to add the interface copybook (CPLNKTCL) and to invoke the a lookup by PCTCTUTL and place the result in the output record, just before the record is written in D3000-BUILD-FCP-REC.

New Bind parameters are included for PPP712 to include the PCTCTUTL program and a subprogram needed by the utility PPRMUT2.

Copylib Changes

CPWSXACP

This copybook defines the layout of the extract file sent to CPS for each appointment. Two bytes of the filler space at the end of the record were used to pass the Grade Type Code for appointments that are graded, leaving 7 bytes of filler.

CPWSXECP

This copybook defines the layout of the extract file sent to CPS for each employee. A one byte filler located at position 408 of the record was used to pass the WOS indicator.

PPTCTUTL and PPRMUT2 have been added to the member list.

3. COBOL Program Installation

At UCOP, all COBOL programs pass through the DB2 pre-compiler, whether or not the program contains embedded SQL, to resolve INCLUDE references. Your site may have different requirements.

Note: “DUAL” programs must be compiled twice and linked into batch and online libraries (“LOADLIB” and “OLOADLIB” respectively). “CICS” programs must be CICS pre-compiled and compiled once and linked into OLOADLIB. “BATCH” programs must be compiled once and linked into the batch LOADLIB only.
