Service Request 81486

Background

Service Request 81486 states “Under California State Assembly Bill 1825 (AB1825), all supervisors are required to complete a sexual harassment training course every two years. The university has contracted with an outside vendor to provide this training.”

Current Process

Service Request 81486 continues “Currently, the university identifies those supervisory employees by a combination of Employee Relations Codes (ERC) and CTOs via a CPS data file to the vendor. Recently, the university determined the current process will not identify employees, who are considered supervisors under the requirements of AB 1825 but who do not meet the HEERA definition of supervisor.”

Proposed Process

The Service Request requests proposes that “a new data element should be established in PPS to identify the 'non-HEERA' supervisors, i.e. employees who supervise only one other employee, who are subject to Sexual Harassment training. In addition, this new data element must be able to be modified via an on-line screen within the PPS application. This new data element should also appear on a history screen.”

Programs:

PPP240

Program PPP240 is a new program that produces a tab-delimited file that contains all employees who have a non-blank value in the special training indicator field.

PPBASFET, PPBASHST, PPBASUPD

These programs access the PPPBAS table. They have been modified to include the new special training field as part of the processing.

PPIIVR

This program creates the interface file to the IVR application and has been modified to add the special training field as part of the interface file.

PPPERCHG, PPPERFET, PPPERUPD, PPPERUTL, PPPERUTW

These programs access the PPPPER table. They have been modified to include the new special training field as part of the processing.

PPP711

This program creates the interface file to CPS application and has been modified to add the special training field to the interface file.

PPWEPER, PPWIBA1, PPWIPER

These are the programs that support the changed on-line screens. They have been modified to support the new special training indicator field.

Copylibs:

CPWSRBAS, CPWSRPER

These members have been modified to support the new Special Training Indicator field that has been added to the PPPBAS and PPPPER tables.

CPWSXECP

This member has been modified so the CPS application will receive the new special training indicator field.

CPWSIVRE

This member has been modified so the Special Training indicator will be sent to the IVR application.

Include Members:

PPPVZBAS, PPPVBAS1, PPPVZPER, PPPVPER1, PPPVPER2

These members have been modified to support the new Special Training Indicator field.

Reporting Requirements:

A new tab delimited output file will be produced on an on-request basis. This file will contain employees that contain a non-blank value in the new special training field. All other existing reports are unchanged.

Production JCL

JCL must be created to execute new program PPP240 on an Ad-hoc basis. Sample JCL has been provided with this release.

Test Plan

A separate Test Plan document is provided for this release.
