Service Request 81533

Service request 81533 requests that "the program which extracts pay rates from the payscale file [PPIRANGE] be modified to use the following logic when searching for matches on sub-location value:

If the campus is using sub-location functionality, the program should first look for a match on the passed sub-location value. If a match is not found, the program should next look for a Title Code entry for sub-location 'GN'. If no 'GN' entry is found, the program should finally look for an entry where the sub-location is '* * *'.

Programs

PPIRANGE

PPIRANGE is a called module used to match pay rates passed with those on the payscale file. It is called by the following programs:

- PPP675 - web merit extract program
- PPP910 - regular range adjustment processing
- PPP920 - range adjustment time file update
- PPP930 - retroactive range adjustment processing

It was modified to attempt to match the payscale file first using the provided sub-location. Then, if no match is found, it will attempt to match using sub-location "GN". If still no match is found, it will attempt to match using sub-location "* * *".

Installation Instructions

1. Install, compile, and link the following **modified** program:

PROGRAM	DB2?	Compile	Package Bind?	Done?
PPIRANGE	No	Batch	No	

2. Install in production.

Test Plan

A separate Test Plan document is provided with this release.

Timing of Installation

The installation of this release is Urgent for campuses using sub-location functionality. For other campuses, the installation is Not Urgent.

Campuses using sub-location functionality should install the release prior to running the Range Adjustment Process to adjust employee rates

As usual, campuses are encouraged to install this release in as timely a fashion as possible, and in the normal numeric sequence of releases.
