Service Request 81768

Service Request 81768 asks that the Derived Percent Time be included in the data sent from campuses for use by the Corporate Personnel System (CPS).

Programs

PPP713

PPP713 creates the distribution file for the Corporate Personnel System (CPS).

The program was modified to populate a new data element that was added in the Corporate Personnel System (CPS) file. The new data element is the Derived Percent Time (PAR0343). Derived Percent Time is the Percent of Time effort associated with an earnings pay distribution.

The Derived Percent Time was simply moved "as is" for all pay cycles except for the BW (biweekly) that crosses the current month and prior month boundary. BW that crosses the current month and prior month boundary, the Derived Percent Time was prorated by the number of working days in the pay period that belong to each month, divided by 10 working days per BW pay period. The same prorating was done for earnings and hours for the earnings pay distribution.

Copy Members

CPWSXDCP

This copy member defines the Working Storage layout of the Corporate Personnel System (CPS). A new element, the Derived Percent Time (PAR0343) was added. Existing FILLER was used to add the Derived Percent Time to the CPS file.

The timing of this release is **date mandated**.

This release must be installed prior to the creation of the CPS Interface file for month-end January, 2008. However, the release may be installed any time prior to that at your location's convenience.
