This release addresses **Phase II** of the following Service Request and the following Error Report:

Service Request 81975

This SR requests enhancements to reports generated by the batch functions associated with the Web Merit process. The online Web Merit System passes Employee Database (EDB) data into its own Merit tables using merit extract batch COBOL program PPP675. Some of the merit data is then changed using the online Web Merit Roster screens. After the online changes have been made, program PPP676 creates merit update transactions that are then applied back to the EDB via batch file maintenance.

The Web Merit EDB Extract Errors and Run Controls Report, PPP6751, is generated by the extract program PPP675. It is requested that this report be split into two reports, one that would list the activity at the employee level as it does now and another that would report any processing errors that might occur. Additional information, including employee name and home department with description, would be added to the first report.

The Web Merit EDB Update Errors and Run Controls Report, PPP6761, is generated by the program PPP676, which generates EDB update transactions from Web Merit tables. It is requested that this report be split into two reports, one that would list the activity at the employee level as it does now and another that would report any employee errors that might be encountered. Additional information, including employee name and home department with description, would be added to the summary of activity report. The employee ID, employee name and appointment department information would be added to the error report.

Phase I release 1789 addressed the reporting out of program PPP676, which generates the EDB update transactions for Web Merit.

This **Phase II** addresses the reporting out of PPP675, the program which extracts EDB data for the Web Merit database tables.

Error Report 2154

After performing a select on the PRM table for the "number of hours in a year", parameter 41, the SQL return code is not evaluated. Therefore, if the return code is bad, the program proceeds with a zero in the number of hours field. Later the program uses this as a multiplier when calculating the annual salary which results in a salary of zero. A perform of the SQL evaluate paragraph needs to be added.

Programs

PPP675

PPP675 is the Web Merit program which extracts EDB data for the Web Merit database tables.

The report PPP6751 previously reported the details about the extract at the employee level and also any processing errors that might occur. This report was split into two reports, an Employee Detail report (PPP6751) and a Web Merit Error Report (PPP6752). Changes were made to the report headings and column heading for the detail report. Also, the employee's name and home department with description were added. The new error report (PPP6752) is the standard error report used by many PPS programs and will display any fatal errors, severity level greater than 7.

An evaluation of the SQL return code was added to the program following the read of the System Parameters table. This was done to address the Error Report described above.
