This document provides installation instructions for release 1850. Please review these instructions carefully before proceeding with the installation.

1. Web Merit Installation

- 1.1 Download and install the .ear or .war file from the release dataset PAYDIST.R1850.MERITEAR or MERITWAR using binary FTP. For details on installation, please see the documentation for releases 1485 and 1668.
- 1.2 Create external login.properties file for the Web Merit application as following:
 - Create an external directory (e.g. c:\webmerit) to be called WEBMERIT_PROPERTY_HOME.
 - Copy the current login.properties file into the WEBMERIT_PROPERTY_HOME directory.
 - Go to the Integrated Solutions Consol (Admin consol for your web server).
 - Expand “Servers” and click on “Application servers”.
 - Find and click on the target server for the Web Merit application.
 - Expand “Java and Process Management” under “Server Infrastructure”.
 - Click on “Process Definition”.
 - Click on “Java Virtual Machine”.
 - Click on “Custom Properties”.
 - Define a new custom property by clicking on “New” button. Enter WEBMERIT_PROPERTY_HOME in the name field and the name of the external directory (e.g. c:\webmerit) in the value field.
 - Save and restart the server.
 - The Web Merit Application will utilize the properties defined in the login.properties file residing in the WEBMERIT_PROPERTY_HOME.

2. Testing

- 2.1 Perform installation verification testing as described in the Test Plan. In addition, perform any further local testing.

3. Install in Production

- 3.1 Place modified objects in production.
