Introduction

This is the complete test plan for the following modifications made to PPS to address the requirements specified by the following service request.

**SR#82496 Add Leave DOS codes to CPS Distribution File and Modify BCS
Deduction File**

Load Employee Data Base (LOADEDDB)

Load the DB2 EDB database.

Verification

Ensure that the DB2 EDB has been successfully restored by verifying normal completion of the job and ensuring that all tables have been successfully loaded into the database. Verification can be made by reviewing the PDS REPORTS member LOADEDDB.

Load Control Table Data Base (LOADCTL)

Load the DB2 CTL database supplied with this release. The CTL updates associated with this release have been applied to this version of the CTL database.

Verification if using CTL supplied with release

Ensure that the DB2 CTL has been successfully restored by verifying normal completion of the job and ensuring that all tables have been successfully loaded into the database. Verification can be made by reviewing the PDS REPORTS member LOADCTL.

Run CPS Interface Process (RUN713)

This program generates three CPS interface files; the FCP Distribution file, the BCS Distribution file and the BCS Deduction file. The PAR input file that has been provided is FNLPARMG.

Verification

Confirm the job ran to successful completion.

Verify that the results match to the REPORTS PDS member RUN713. The interface files created can be compared to the interface files provided with this release.

T713BCSD
T713DEDO
T713DIST

Note that T713DIST now includes leave type distributions. These are records with "LV" in columns 29-30.

File T713DEDO now includes tax type deductions. For example, there are records for Federal Tax, GTN 014 in columns 14-16.

File T713BCSD had no changes.
