### **Service Request 82742**

Service Request 82742 asks for the addition of a new DOS code to support the Furlough Exchange Program.

Service Request 82742 provides the following background information:

The Furlough Exchange Program allows academic employees who are subject to the furlough program to devote extra effort to extramurally funded projects in exchange for the furlough time they would be accruing. Appointees may charge an equivalent amount of effort to extramural funding, provided this is permissible with the granting agency and the terms of the extramural award as determined in consultation with the campus Sponsored Projects Office (SPA). All charges must remain in compliance with Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-21. Restricted gifts and endowments that can be used for research support may be used to support this increased effort.
