¹ Doctoral entry cohorts: students who first enrolled at the campus in any academic doctoral degree program (e.g., Ph.D., Ed.D.), General Campus or Health Sciences. Excludes students who initially enrolled in the program as masters students. Also excludes students in health science professional doctoral degree programs (e.g., M.D.), in J.D. programs, or in double or joint majors or joint degree programs.

² Doctoral degree completion is measured by award of the degree by the summer of the 10th year after entry.

³ Includes architecture, business, communications, education, home economics, law (Ph.D. only), library sciences, nursing, public health, and social work.

⁴ Includes enrollments in interdisciplinary programs and unclassified studies.

⁵ Attrition: Students were defined as having "left" (dropped out) if they were not registered during the spring term of their 10th year AND were not registered during any term of their 11th year AND had not completed the doctoral degree by the summer of the 10th year.

***Total entry cohort (3 years) is less than 15; therefore, completion rate should be viewed cautiously. **Total cohort is 5 or less. (Numbers are included in UC totals.)**
