This User Agreement does not involve any exchange of funds.

Article 10., Subcontractor Personnel Performing Work at Contractor's Facility, states that Battelle will provide any required hazards training for personnel visiting INL. The University Principal Investigator and any other University personnel visiting Oak Ridge under this User Agreement are responsible for complying with Oak Ridge's health and safety rules.

The term of this User Agreement will generally be five years from the date that it is fully executed. (See Article II.)
