Smoke and Tobacco Free Student Fellowships

The UC Systemwide Smoke and Tobacco Free Task Force is soliciting applications for its 2017-18 student fellowships. The purpose of these awards is to help foster the next generation of leaders to reduce the harms and social costs from smoking and use of tobacco products worldwide, and to enable UC to be a leader among university systems in maintaining smoke and tobacco free environments.

Fellows will be awarded \$12,000 in support for a one-year project that advances the goals of UC's landmark Smoke and Tobacco Free Policy. Applications are due by noon, May 12, 2017.

- **UC smoke and tobacco free policy enforcement**
Projects that design and pilot feasible and effective enforcement strategies
- **Campus awareness and engagement**
- Creative projects that engage the campus community and raise awareness of tobacco and nicotine products and their impact on health and the environment
- **Wellness and Health**
Projects that target reductions in smoking and tobacco use among students, staff, faculty, patients and communities.

Applications due by 12 p.m., May 12, 2017.
