KAISER BUILDING EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

FIRE

- If you discover a fire of any size, <u>activate the nearest fire</u> alarm pull station. Dial 911or 272-0909 (Kaiser Security Control Center) to report the exact location & type of fire.
- If safe to do so, call Security at **272-0909** to advise them of the location/severity of the fire. Warn others in the immediate area.
- Do <u>not</u> use the elevators. People occupying the fire floor, the floor above the fire, and the floor below the fire will relocate down four floors within the building (sixth floor and above only). Fifth floor or lower will evacuate the building and wait at the pre-designated area (325 Lot, 21st Street and One Kaiser Plaza). Relocation will be directed by the Floor Wardens, on-duty Property Manager/Life Safety, Emergency Response Team, and the Fire Department. Disabled persons unable to negotiate the stairs are to enter the Center stairwell once it is safe to do so & stay there with the Disabled Person Monitor for evacuation by the OFD.
- Use an extinguisher <u>only</u> if the fire is small and it is safe to do so.

Check in with your Floor Warden at the relocation site.

WORKPLACE VIOLENCE

- If a person's behavior becomes inappropriate or violent, leave the area if possible and notify Security and your supervisor. If you feel you are in imminent danger, dial 911.
- Trust your instincts. Try to create physical space between you and any threatening person.
- Suspicious persons should be reported to Security at **272-0909**. Security will notify the Oakland Police if necessary.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- **Dial 911** Give street address, floor, room number and type of emergency.
- Call 272-0909 (emergency) Inform Security of situation and exact location.

For Cardiac Arrest (or possible heart attacks/unconsciousness)

- Call 911
- Instruct a co-worker to retrieve the nearest *AED* (defibrillator) [6th Floor hallway or 12th Floor conference room].
- Instruct a co-worker to find a trained AED-CPR rescuer (look for red/white 'AED' sticker on nameplates).
- Call **272-0909** to notify them of the situation. They will hold an elevator for responding Emergency Services.
- Call 7-0600 (Work Management Center) to report the incident
- Stay with the patient do <u>not</u> move them!

EARTHQUAKE

- *Duck, Cover and Hold* in place until the shaking stops.
- Face away from windows and stay clear of falling objects.
- Stay Inside! Do <u>not</u> evacuate unless directed to do so.
- Do not use the stairs until instructed that it is safe to do so.
- Once the earthquake has stopped, survey your area. Report all injuries and damage to Security at (510) 272-0909.
- Be prepared for aftershocks.

Follow directions given over the Building PA system or by your Floor Warden.

CIVIL UNREST/TERRORISM

- In the event of civil unrest or a terrorism incident, you will be notified via the Building PA system. Follow instructions.
- You will be advised as to the nature of the situation, and whether to evacuate or if it is unsafe to leave the building.

BOMB THREATS

Ask caller the following questions:

- When will it explode?
- Where/what type of device?
- What does it look like?
- What is your name?
- Check caller ID for phone #.
- Note caller's voice/sounds.
- Notify Security at (510) 272-0909.

Notify Security of any unusual items in your area – do not touch them.
