Dear Colleague:

I am pleased to share with you the *Information Digest 2002*. The *Digest* includes undergraduate student application, admissions, and enrollment data as well as information concerning the retention, graduation, and time-to-degree of UC undergraduates. For over 11 years, the *Digest* has been produced by staff in Student Academic Services in the Office of the President to describe the admissions process Universitywide and to report upon the performance of undergraduates as measured by their persistence, graduation, and time-to-degree rates. This edition of the *Digest* includes admissions information through Fall 2000 (and Fall 2001 data, where available), along with student outcome data up to Fall 1999.

This year's *Information Digest* has been significantly revised and expanded. New data tables have been added for both freshmen and transfer students. In addition, a new section is included that presents information about the admission and enrollment of undergraduates at each of UC's eight undergraduate campuses. These revisions were incorporated in response to requests my office received throughout the year for data concerning the University's undergraduate students.

While the *Information Digest* presents a wealth of data concerning students at the University, you should be aware that additional data are located on the Student Academic Services website at <http://www.ucop.edu/sas/>. Information concerning student financial support, UC course articulation with California community colleges, UC "a-f" course listings for all high schools in California, and past editions of the *Information Digest* can be found at this site, along with information for many Universitywide programs, services, and publications.
