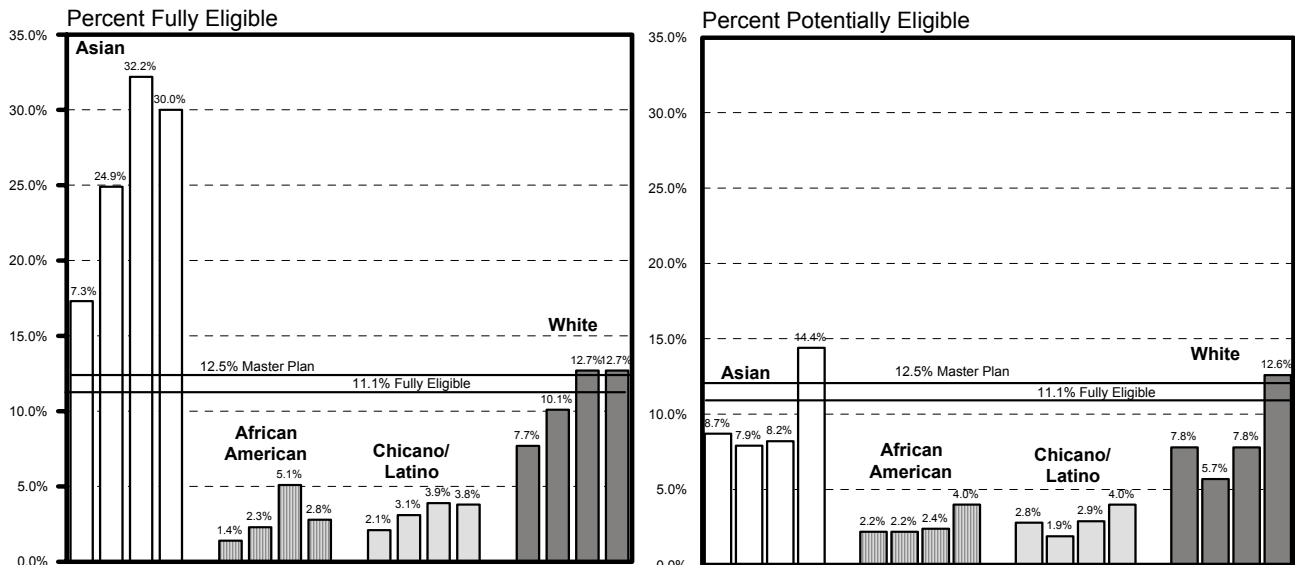

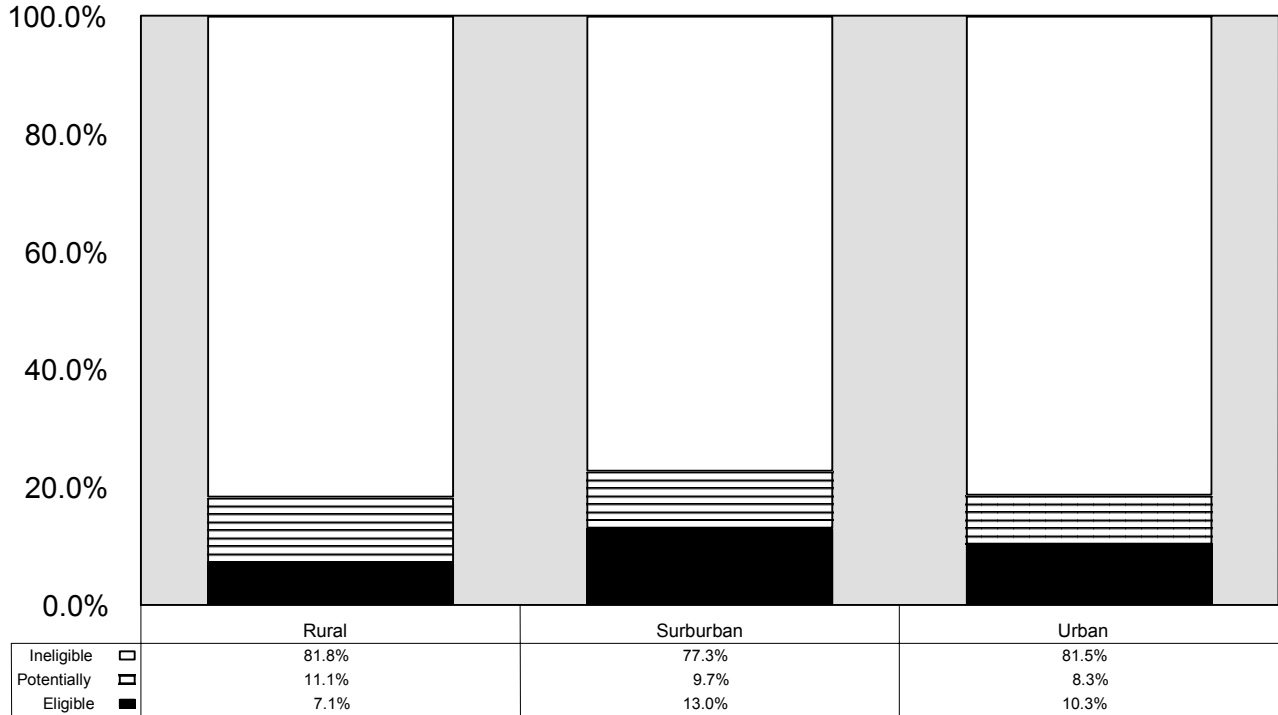
**California Public High School Graduates

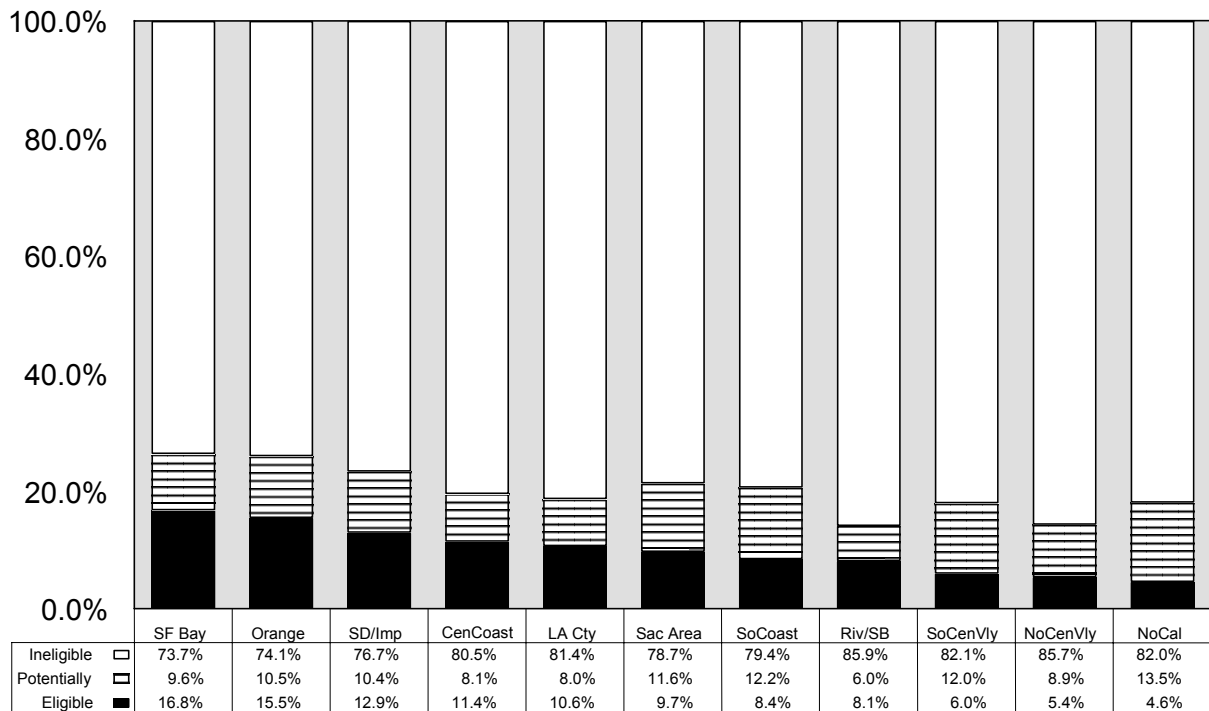
