A. Admissions Data

1. UC Campus

Report the total number of applications, admits, and enrolled students to your campus from California community college students, by student race/ethnicity.

2. Service Area Community Colleges

Report the total number of applications, admits, and enrolled students to your campus from California community colleges in your service area (by student race/ethnicity).

3. All Other Community Colleges

Report the total number of applications, admits, and enrolled students to your campus from California community colleges outside your service area (by student race/ethnicity).

B. Course Articulation

1. Service Area Community Colleges

a. Report the number of community colleges with which you have established major (or course-to-course) articulation agreements.

b. Report the median number of majors articulated with service area community colleges.

2. All Other Community Colleges

a. Number of community colleges with which you have established major and (or course-to-course) articulation agreements.
