******* IMPORTANT NOTICE*******

AS AUTHORIZED BY CALIFORNIA STATE GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 12419.5, THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA WILL REQUEST THE STATE CONTROLLER TO FORWARD TO THE UNIVERSITY ANY INCOME TAX REFUND OR ANY OTHER AMOUNTS THE STATE MAY OWE YOU AS PAYMENT ON THE AMOUNT YOU OWE ON YOUR STUDENT LOAN(S). YOU MAY OWE MORE THAN THE AMOUNTS SHOWN ON THIS STATEMENT IF ADDITIONAL INSTALLMENTS COME DUE AND/OR YOU ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR LATE FEES, COLLECTION COSTS AND/OR LITIGATION COSTS. REFER TO THE ENCLOSURE FOR ADDITIONAL, IMPORTANT INFORMATION.

AS MENTIONED ON THE ENCLOSED STATEMENT, The University of California will request the State Controller to forward to the University any income tax refund or any other amounts the state may owe you, or your spouse, if filing jointly, to intercept the amount you owe on your student loan (s).

YOU CAN AVOID HAVING YOUR MONEY SEIZED if you bring all of your loans current by [November 14, 2003](#).

FAILURE TO RESOLVE YOUR LOAN DELINQUENCY AT THIS TIME MAY RESULT IN FURTHER COLLECTION ACTION AGAINST YOU. Questions regarding this notice should be directed to the Loan Collection Office at your campus.
