AB 699 (Portantino)

Requires the Secretary of Labor and Workforce Development to collaborate with the Secretaries of Business, Transportation and Housing and Food and Agriculture in leading the preparation of the California Economic Development Strategic Plan and would require the panel to assess specified matters in preparing the plan, to consult with other state entities, and to review and include certain materials appropriate to completion of the plan.

AB 867 (Nava)

Authorizes CSU to award the Doctor of Nursing Practice degree, distinguishes the Doctor of Nursing Practice degree from the UC research-based doctoral degrees.

SB 19 (Simitian)

Amends existing law requiring the convening of a working group representing specified entities, including UC, to create a strategic plan to link education data systems so that these provisions would be implemented using American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) funding.

AB 1207 (Logue)

Requires a person who otherwise meets the existing eligibility requirements for resident tuition, but who is without lawful immigration status, to pay nonresident tuition until he or she obtains lawful immigration status.

SB 86 (Yee)

Prohibits UC and the California State University from increasing monetary compensation or approving payment of a bonus for any executive officer in any year in which the amount of General Fund moneys appropriated to the segment is less than or equal to the amount appropriated in the preceding fiscal year. The University has an oppose position on the bill.

SUMMARY:

Prohibits a person employed by the state whose base salary is greater than a specified amount, receiving a salary increase while employed in the same position or classification. Requires all funds that are saved to be deposited in the fund of the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection for purchase of firefighting aircraft.

STATUS: 09/08/2009 INTRODUCED.

Commentary:

Prohibits a person employed by the state whose base salary on the effective date of the bill is greater than \$150,000 per year from receiving a salary increase while employed in the same position or classification. Urges the UC Regents and Board of Directors of Hastings to adopt the policy expressed in the bill.

Public Protection and Physician Health Program Act of 2009.

Authorizes the Department of Public Health to establish a program with the goal of reducing the associated risks from tobacco smoke for hospital patients, staff, and visitors, and to encourage and assist these persons to quit smoking.

AB 613 (Beall)

Requires the Department of Health Care Services in pursuing means to improve and streamline the Medi-Cal treatment authorization request (TAR) process, to do so in specified ways, including performing a cost-benefit analysis for each TAR and reducing the number of TARs required.
