Relates to whistleblower protections: Gives UC and CSU employees the same protections as all other state employees - provides that action for damages may not be brought unless UC and CSU has reached or failed to reach a decision within Regent-established or Trustees-established time limits, and states that these provisions are not intended to prohibit an injured party from seeking a remedy if UC or CSU have not satisfactorily addressed the complaint within 18 months.

Prohibits a person employed by the state whose base salary is greater than a specified amount, receiving a salary increase while employed in the same position or classification. Requires all funds that are saved to be deposited in the fund of the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection for purchase of firefighting aircraft.

Commentary:

Prohibits a person employed by the state whose base salary on the effective date of the bill is greater than \$150,000 per year from receiving a salary increase while employed in the same position or classification.
