- Staff or non-Senate academic employees serve as non-voting advisors

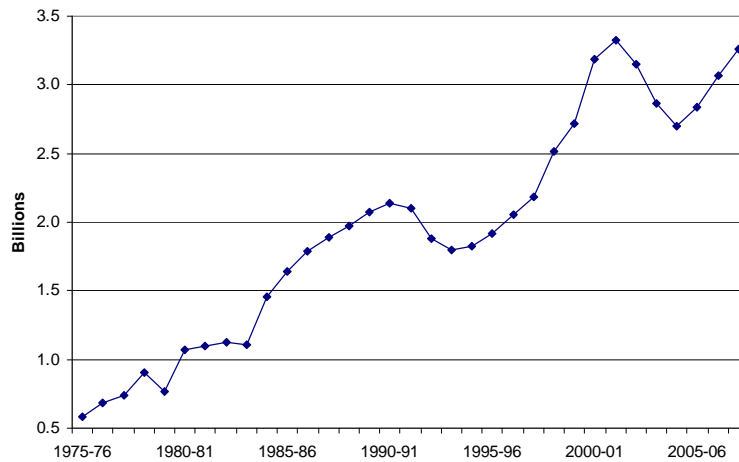
Goals of the Positions

State General Fund Support Adjusted for Inflation and Enrollment

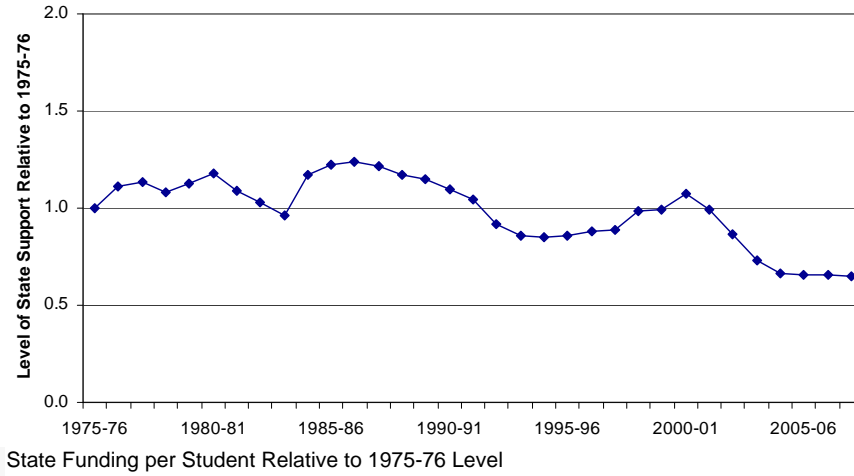
