**VICE PRESIDENT FOR BUDGET****Delegation of Authority for Negotiation, Approval, and Execution of Licenses, Easements, and Rights-of-Way**

Section 100.4 of the Standing Orders of The Regents, Duties of the President of the University, states:

(jj) The President is authorized to approve and execute licenses, easements, and rights-of-way with respect to real property used or to be used for University-related purposes when (1) the consideration does not exceed \$10 million or (2) such instruments are revocable with 120 days' notice.

\* \* \*

As used in the Standing Orders, the term *University-related purposes* refers to real property and interests therein used in furtherance of the University's mission, but excluding real property held for investment purposes.

Effective immediately, you are delegated the authority to approve and execute licenses, easements, and rights-of-way with respect to real property that is or will be used for University-related purposes when the consideration does not exceed \$10 million or when the instruments are revocable with 120 days' notice.

With respect to any options to expand the premises or extend the term of any license, easement or right-of-way agreement exercisable by the University as optionee, you are delegated authority to approve and execute the exercise of such options provided that: (1) the option terms, which are deemed to be a new license, easement or right-of-way agreement for purposes of determining approval authority, conform to the conditions set forth above; or (2) the authority to exercise the option has otherwise been delegated to the President.

You are further delegated authority to approve and execute ancillary documents, amendments or other modifications to any license, easement or right-of-way within the authority of the President.

Any redelegation of the above authority shall be in writing with copies to the Universitywide Policy Coordinator and the General Counsel and Vice President for Legal Affairs. This delegation supersedes the delegation of authority issued June 14, 1996 (DA 2062) to the Senior Vice President--Business and Finance on this same subject.
