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**Insurance Coverage for Students Engaged in  
Off-Campus Activities**

When students travel to participate in off-campus activities sponsored and supervised by the University, they are covered 24 hours a day, worldwide, for a wide variety of accidents and incidents while away from the campus. Effective October 1, 2007, ACE USA became the University’s Student Off-Campus Travel Accident insurance provider.

This broad coverage is provided at no cost to students, but **the student will need to register all out-of-state and foreign country travel at [www.uctrips-insurance.org](http://www.uctrips-insurance.org) to ensure coverage for each covered off-campus activity.** Upon registration, students will receive confirmation of coverage and information to use in an emergency while traveling both domestically and abroad. Coverage is also provided for in-state off-campus activities, but registration is not needed for those trips.

The following travel assistance services and benefits are available to a student who travels 100+miles from campus to participate University sponsored and supervised off-campus activities:

➤ Security extraction (not subject to the mileage limitation)	➤ Accident/sickness medical expense (U.S. \$10,000/occurrence; Foreign \$100,000/occurrence)
➤ Emergency medical evacuation	➤ Other travel assistance services
➤ Repatriation of remains	

➤ Benefits for accidental death, accidental dismemberment, and paralysis

Coverage is also provided to students’ traveling companions, defined as a person or persons with whom the student has coordinated the travel arrangements and who intends to travel with the student during the covered trip. Traveling companions may include a spouse/domestic partner, children or other person(s).

By registering travel to out-of-state and foreign University sponsored and supervised off-campus activities, students ensure their own coverage and help the University maintain the best possible and most cost-effective coverage for the entire University community, ensure that emergency resources are available in travel destinations, and help protect their health, safety and security.
