Description of Work

The University of California Office of the President (UCOP) is located in 1111 Franklin Street, Oakland, California. Its building is a 12-story office building with a basement with multiple parking levels from the basement to the 4th floor. The approximate overall gross square floor is 353,200 SF with roof areas of approximately 26,400 SF.

The existing exterior maintenance systems (window and façade washing systems) are in need of retrofitting to comply with applicable codes and regulations. UCOP seeks qualified contractors to submit responses to this advertisement by responding to the attached prequalification questionnaire.

The proposed scope of work will be to:

- 1. Furnish labor and materials to design, fabricate and install complete exterior maintenance equipment systems per the bridging documents consisting of drawings and performance specs to be issued at the time of bidding.
- 2. Furnish labor and materials to design, fabricate and install OSHA required safety features on the roofs per the bridging documents consisting of drawings and performance specs to be issued at the time of bidding.

Persons arriving late will not be allowed to submit proposals as design builder on the project. Proposal Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Proposal, excluding alternates, shall accompany each bid. The surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the bid deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120)

All insurance policies required to be obtained by Design Builder shall be subject to approval by University for form and substance. All such policies shall be issued by a company rated by Best as A- or better with a financial classification of VIII or better, or have equivalent rating by Standard and Poor's or Moody's.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage at the location of the work

The work described in the contract is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

No design builder or subcontractor, regardless of tier, may be listed on a Bid for, or engage in the performance of, any portion of this project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 and 1771.1.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The successful Bidder shall pay all persons providing construction services and/or any labor on site, including any University location, no less than the UC Fair Wage (defined as \$15 per hour) and shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local working condition requirements.

The successful proposer will be required to have the following California contractor's license at the time of the proposal opening:
