Subject: Approval of Travel and Entertainment Expenses

Business and Finance Bulletin G-28, *Policy and Regulations Governing Travel*, requires that any person who is authorized to approve travel expenses not approve his or her own travel expenses or those of a near relative. Similarly, the University requires that persons do not approve their own entertainment expenses (Business and Finance Bulletin BUS-79, *Expenditures for Business Meetings, Entertainment, and Other Occasions*).

For ease of administration, for the following positions the approving authority for travel and entertainment expenses will be as follows:

Secretary and Chief of Staff to The Regents	
General Counsel and Vice President for Legal Affairs

Executive Vice Presidents Senior Vice Presidents	Provost
The Regents Senior Vice President—Chief Compliance & Audit Officer Vice Presidents (direct reports to the President)	Executive Vice President—Business Operations

Expense reimbursement for other positions such as Vice President—who does not report directly to the President—or Associate Vice President should be approved by the individual's supervisor.

The General Counsel and Vice President for Legal Affairs may serve as the approving authority in the absence of the designated primary approval authority.

This replaces the approval authority matrix issued by my office on May 11, 2010.
