















High Schools Served by EAOP, MESA, and Puente by API Decile Rank, AY2015-16




High Schools Served by EAOP, MESA, and Puente by FRPM Rate, AY2015-16




High School Students Served by EAOP, MESA, and Puente by Ethnicity, AY2015-16
