- Emerged out of **student demands**, after **Prop 209** passed in 1996
- Student **leadership & advocacy**
- **Student-led** outreach strategies
- Targeting **at-risk, low income, first-generation, and underrepresented students.**
- **Flexible** framework for each UC SIP
- **Advances & Supports** student access to the UC system

Increase college-going rates and graduate and professional school enrollment among its target population of first-generation, low-income and underrepresented students.

Goal

Increase college-going rates and graduate/professional school enrollment

Objectives & Funding


Objectives

- 50% of 12th grade students will enroll in postsecondary institutions
- 55% of graduating undergraduate volunteers will enroll in graduate school.

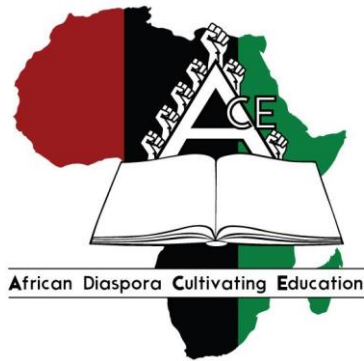

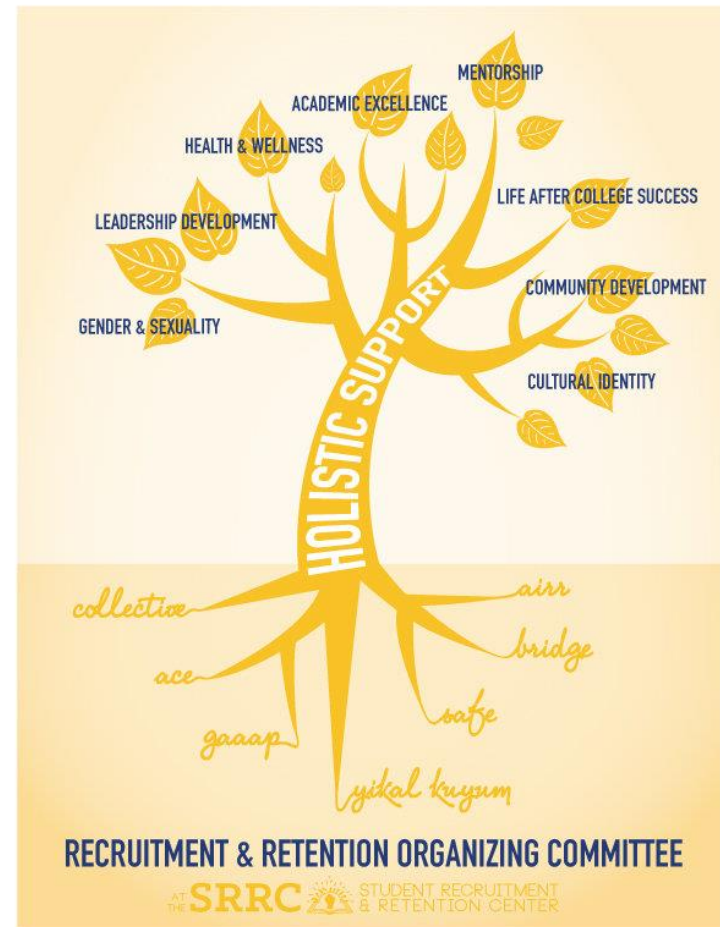

 - cultural awareness & development




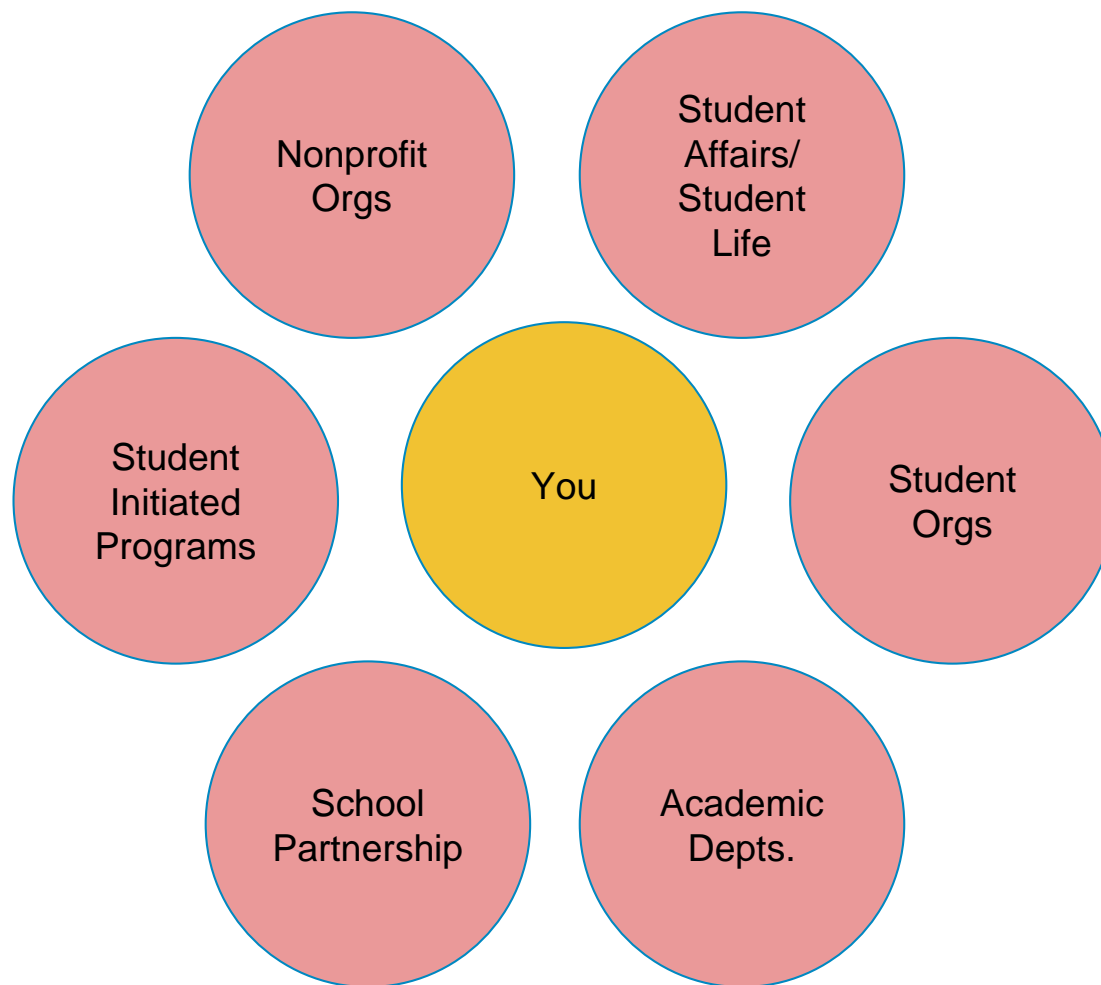

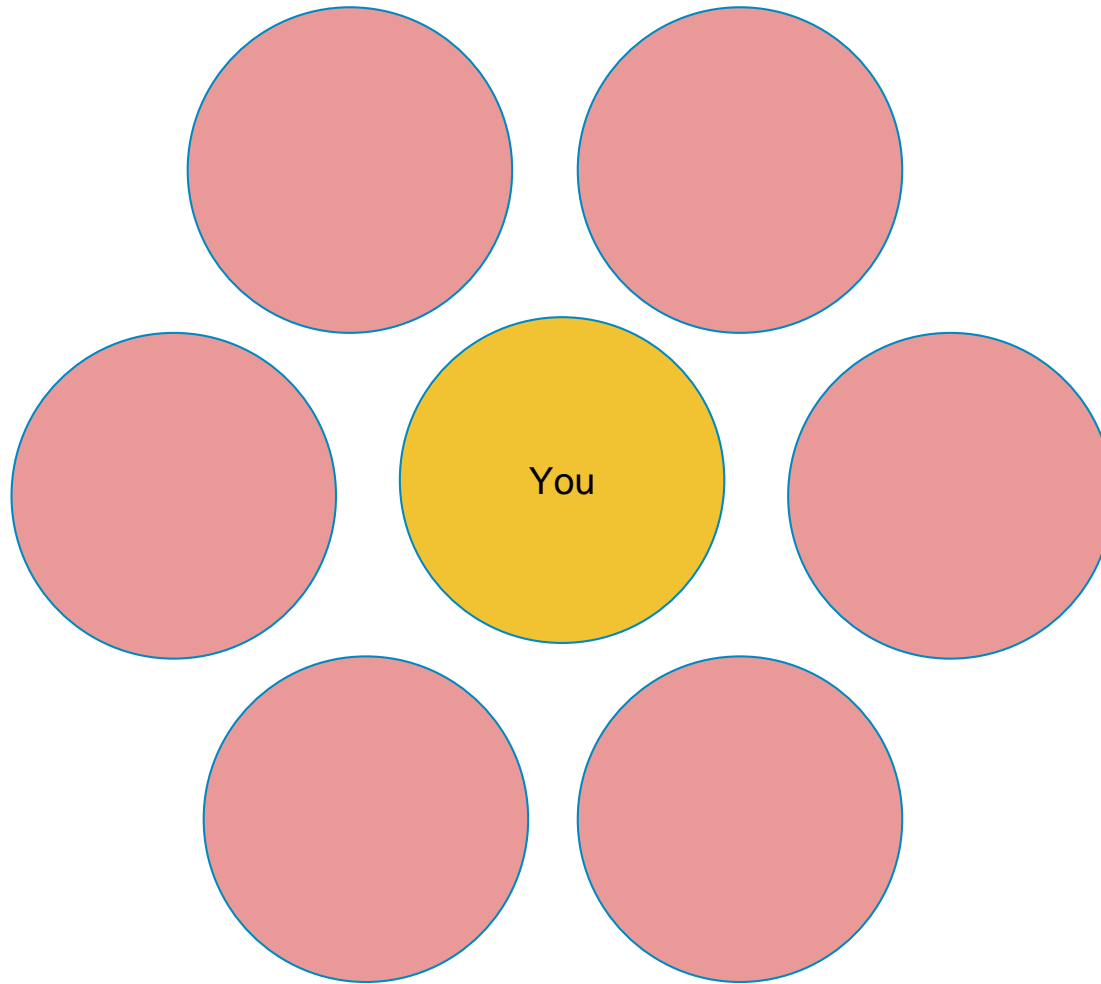
